ACQUISITION OF LANDS

Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 258 of the Constitution of India, the President has in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Co-operation (Department of Agriculture) Notification No. 4(1)/65, General II, dated 23rd April 1966, entrusted to the Government of Tamil Nadu, with their consent, the functions of the Union Government under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894), in relation to the Acquisition of land for the purpose of the Union Government in this State;

And, whereas, the lands specified in the Schedule below are needed for a public purpose, to wit, for the doubling of Railway Track between Irugur and Coimbatore Junction notice to that effect is hereby given to all to whom it may concern in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (Central Act I of 1894).

And, in view of the urgency of the case is become necessary to acquire immediate possession of the lands specified in the Schedule below, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that the lands be acquired under the provisions of sub-section (2) of Section 17 of the said Act.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 4 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby authorize the Revenue Divisional Officer, Coimbatore and his/her staff and workmen to exercise the powers conferred by the said sub-section and under clause (c) of Section 3 of the same Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby appoints the Revenue Divisional Officer, Coimbatore to perform the functions of the Collector under sub-section 5A of the Act. Under the sub-section (4) of Section 17 of the said Act, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that in View of the urgency of the case, the provisions of Section 5A of the Act, shall not apply to this case.
