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BILLS INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU

Under rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 26th March 2010 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:-

L.A. BILL No. 14 of 2010

A Bill to provide for the appropriation of certain further moneys out of Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the finan year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2009.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-first of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.2) Act, 2010.

Supplementary appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial 1st day of April 2009.

- 2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the \$ for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of A 2009, a further sum not exceeding one thousand seven hundred and forty nine crores seven year which commenced on the three lakhs and twenty three thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet-
 - (a) the supplementary grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for that y as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
 - (b) the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State for t year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

- A Bill to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2010.
- BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:-
 - 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2010.

Short title.

2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State Withdrawal of certain sums not exceeding forty two thousand five hundred and sixty three crores twenty eight lakhs and fourteen thousand rupees being moneys required to meet-

sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for a part commencing on the 1st day of April 2010.

- (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial of the financial year year commencing on the 1st day of April 2010, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- 3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under Appropriation. section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

This Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 206 of the Cosntitution, to provide for the withdrawal from and out of the consolidated fund of State, of certain sums being required to meet—

- (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly in respect of estimated expenditure of the State for a part of the financial year commencing on the first day of April 2010; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the said Fund for the said part of that year, and for the appropriation of the said sums.
