In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Central Act II of 1899), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Commercial Taxes Department Notification No.II(2)/CT/1582/98, published at page 330 in Part II-Section 2 of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 12th August 1998 as subsequently amended:—

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 5th July, 2012.
