ALLOCATION OF SUBJECTS AMONG MINISTERS

No. I/PUSP/33(a-2)/2012.

Under Clause (3) of Article 166 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that:

(i) Tmt. B. Valarmathi, Minister for Social Welfare will additionally hold the portfolio of 'Nutritious Noon Meal Programme' and she may be designated as Minister for Social Welfare and Nutritious Noon Meal Programme.

(ii) The portfolio of 'Environment and Pollution Control' may be allocated to Thiru M.C. Sampath and he may be designated as Minister for Environment.

(iii) The portfolio of Commercial Taxes and Registration and Stamp Act may be allocated to Thiru B.V. Ramanaa and he may be designated as Minister for Commercial Taxes and Registration.

(iv) Thiru N.R. Sivapathy, Minister for School Education, Sports & Youth Welfare will additionally hold the portfolio "Law, Courts and Prisons, Personnel and Administrative Reforms and Prevention of Corruption" and he may be designated as Minister for School Education, Sports & Youth Welfare, Law, Courts and Prisons.
