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BILLS INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU

Under Rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 29th March 2012 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:—

L.A. Bill No. 11 OF 2012

A Bill to provide for the appropriation of certain further moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2011.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.2) Act, 2012.
- 2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2011, a further sum not exceeding five thousand nine hundred and eighty three crore seventy lakhs thirteen thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet--
 - (a) the supplementary grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for that year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the supplementary expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Short title.

Supplementary appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2011.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

This Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 206 of the Constitution, to provide for the withdrawal from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State, of certain sums being required to meet—

(a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly in respect of estimated expenditure of the State for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2012; and

(b) the expenditure charged on the said Fund for the said part of that year, and for the appropriation of the said sums.
