# BILL INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU

Under Rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 30th March 2012 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:—

L.A. Bill No. 13 of 2012

#### A Bill further to amend the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Amendment) Act, 2012.

Short title and commencement.

- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th October, 2011.
- 2. To section 82 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994, the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

Amendment of section 82.

"Provided that the president may be paid a monthly honorarium, as may be fixed by the Government from time to time.".

#### STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

An announcement was made on the floor of the Legislative Assembly by the Hon'ble Minister (Municipal Administration and Rural Development) that the Government will sanction monthly honorarium to the Presidents of Village Panchayats. Accordingly, the Government have decided to make necessary provision in the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994) by amending section 82 of the said Act suitably.

2. The Bill seeks to give effect to the above said decision.
