The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 30th March 2012 and is hereby published for general information:—

#### ACT No. 11 OF 2012.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of certain further moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2011.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.2) Act, 2012.
- Supplementary appropriation out of Consolidated purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2011.
- 2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day Fund of the State for of April 2011, a further sum not exceeding five thousand nine hundred and eighty three the services and crore seventy lakhs thirteen thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet-
  - (a) the supplementary grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for that year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
  - (b) the supplementary expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
