BILLS INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU

Under Rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 15th May 2013 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:—

L.A. Bill No. 19 of 2013

A Bill to provide for the appropriation of money out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2013.

Short title.

2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013, a sum not exceeding one lakh fifty one thousand eight hundred and seventy two crores sixty eight lakhs and eighty eight thousand rupees which shall be inclusive of the sum of seventy six thousand six hundred and nine crore forty three lakhs and seventy six thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2013 being moneys required to meet—

Tamil Nadu Act 6 of 2013.

- (a) the grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013.
