2. The Selection Committee shall,—

- finalise the selection of member within three months from the date on which the reference is made to it.
  - recommend a panel of two names for every vacancy referred to it

- satisfy itself, before recommending any person for appointment as Member of Tamil Nadu Electricity Regulatory Commission, that such person does not have any financial or other interest which is likely to affect prejudicially his function as Member.
