CONSTITUTION OF DISTRICT MUNSIF-CUM-JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE COURT AT PERAIYOOR IN MADURAI DISTRICT
UNDER THE TAMIL NADU CIVIL COURTS ACT.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the second paragraph of Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of District Munsif to be appointed to the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Peraiyoor in Madurai District as **One** with effect on and from the date on which the District Munsif assume charge of that Court.
