Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

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The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the President on the 31st August 2013 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 17 OF 2013.

An Act further to amend the Indian Partnership Act, 1932 in its application to the State of Tamil Nadu

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title,
extent and
commence-
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Partnership (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Act, 2013.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. For Schedule I to the Indian Partnership Act, 1932, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:—

(3) Intimation under section 61	- Fifty rupees.
(4) Intimation under section 62	- Fifty rupees.
(5) Notice under section 63	- Fifty rupees.
(6) Application under section 64	- Fifty rupees.
(7) Inspection of the Register of Firms under sub-section (1) of section 66	- Twenty five rupees for inspection of the entry of each firm in the Register.
(8) Inspection of documents relating to a firm under sub-section (2) of section 66	- Fifty rupees for each inspection of all documents relating to one firm.
(9) Copies from the Register of Firms	- Ten rupees for each hundred words or part thereof."

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the President on the 3rd September 2013 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 18 OF 2013.

An Act further to amend the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 in its application to the State of Tamil Nadu.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Stamp (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Act, 2012.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.

(3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

Central Act II

2. In Schedule I to the Indian Stamp Act, 1899,—

Amendment of
Central Act
II of 1899.

(1) in Article 5, for clause (i), the following clause shall be substituted, namely: —

“(i) if relating to
construction of building

One rupee for every hundred rupees or
part thereof of the cost of the proposed
construction or the value of
construction or the consideration
specified in the agreement,
whichever is higher.

Explanation.—For the purpose of this clause, “building” includes any unit, residential, commercial, institutional, industrial or otherwise proposed to be constructed on an undivided share of land.”;

(2) in Article 45, in clause (a), for the expression, “partition, subject to the maximum of Rs.10,000 per share”, the expression “partition” shall be substituted;

(3) in Article 46, in clause (b), for the expression, “partition, subject to the maximum of Rs.10,000 per share”, the expression “partition” shall be substituted;

(4) in Article 55, in clause A, for the expression, “release, subject to the maximum of Rs.10,000”, the expression “release” shall be substituted; and

(5) in Article 58, in clause (a), in sub-clause (i), for the expression, “settlement, subject to the maximum of Rs.10,000”, the expression “settlement” shall be substituted.

ACT No. 19 OF 2013.

An Act further to amend the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 in its application to the State of Tamil Nadu.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Stamp (Tamil Nadu Third Amendment) Act, 2012.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.

(3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

2. In Schedule I to the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, in Article 58, in clause (a), in the Explanation under sub-clause (i), for the expression "grandchild", the expression "grandchild, brother or sister" shall be substituted.
