Under the Explanation to Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Central Act XXVI of 1881), read with the Notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, No. 20-25-26, Public-I, dated the 8th June, 1957, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares Wednesday, the 4th December, 2013, the date on which the poll for the Bye-election to Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly from 83. Yercaud (ST) Assembly Constituency will take place, to be a public holiday for the areas comprised in the above Assembly Constituency lying in Salem District.
