AMENDMENT TO FORMULATION OF TAMIL NADU RURAL EMPLOYMENT GUARANTEE SCHEME UNDER NATIONAL
RURAL EMPLOYMENT GUARANTEE ACT

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (Central Act 42 of 2005), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department Notification No.II(2)/RDPR/402(b)/2006, published at pages 1 to 28 of Part II—Section 2 of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* Extraordinary, dated the 2nd August 2006, as subsequently amended:-

AMENDMENT

In the said Notification in Chapter-I, for clause 1.2, the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“1.2 Status:

The objective of the Scheme is to provide livelihood security for the households in the notified rural areas of Tamil Nadu by providing atleast one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work in normal circumstances. An additional employment of upto fifty days shall be provided in such Taluks / Blocks which are notified as drought affected Taluks/Blocks and the additional cost incurred in this regard shall be shared between the Central and State Governments as per the funding pattern provided in Section 22 of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (Central Act 42 of 2005). The provisions of Section 7 of the said Act with regard to payment of unemployment allowance shall be applicable to such additional employment”.
