### NOTIFICATION BY THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA

APPOINTMENT OF DATES FOR VARIOUS STAGES OF BYE-ELECTION TO TAMIL NADU LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY FROM 227.NANGUNERI ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCY AND FIXATION OF HOURS OF POLL TO FILL A VACANCY CAUSED BY THE RESIGNATION OF A MEMBER

The following Notification of the Election Commission of India, Nirvachan Sadan, Ashoka Road, New Delhi-110 001, dated 23rd September, 2019 [1 Asvina, 1941 (Saka)] is published:

**No.100/TN-LA/24/2019:-** Whereas, the seat of Shri H Vasantha Kumar, in the Legislative Assembly of the Tamil Nadu State, elected from 227-Nanguneri Assembly Constituency has become vacant on 29-05-2019, by reason of resignation; and

2. Whereas, a bye-election is to be held for the purpose of filling the vacancy so caused; and

3. Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-section (1) of Section 150 and Sections 30 and 56 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Election Commission of India hereby:-

(A) Calls upon the said 227-Nanguneri Assembly Constituency in the State of Tamil Nadu to elect, before the 27-10-2019 (Sunday) and in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder, a person, for the purpose of filling the said vacancy in the Legislative Assembly of the State; and

**(B) Appoints**, with respect to the said election,-

- (a) the 30-09-2019 (Monday), as the last date for making nominations;
- (b) the 1-10-2019 (Tuesday), as the date for scrutiny of nominations;
- (c) the 03-10-2019 (Thursday), as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures;
- (d) the 21-10-2019 (Monday), as the date, on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken;
- (e) the 27-10-2019 (Sunday), as the date before which the election shall be completed, and

**(C) Fixes the hours** from 7.00 A.M. to 6.00 P.M. as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken on the date specified above, for the election.
