ISSUE OF POSTAL BALLOT TO ELECTORS ABOVE THE AGE OF 80 YEARS AND ELECTORS WITH  
PHYSICAL DISABILITY

The following Notifications of the Election Commission of India, Nirvachan Sadan, Ashoka Road, New Delhi-110 001, dated 26th February, 2021(14Magh 1942 (Saka), is published:

In pursuance of the provisions of clause (c) of Section-60 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission hereby specifies that the electors above the age of 80 years and electors with physical disability (benchmark) as already marked/flagged in the data base of the electoral rolls of the State/Union Territory and who request for voting by postal ballot paper and subject to the verification of his request by Returning Officer concerned, would be a class of persons to give vote by postal ballot in the general elections or bye-elections in the State/Union Territory concerned, to be notified under Section 30 of Representation of the People, 1951, as per the provisions in Part-III A of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, as amended *vide* Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India, Notification SO No. 3786(E), dated 22nd October, 2019, and the directions and guidelines issued by the Election Commission.
