WHEREAS, the Tamil Nadu State Election Commission has notified the schedule for the conduct of urban local body elections as per Statutory Order read above.

WHEREAS, since there is no provision in Tamil Nadu Town Panchayats, Municipalities and Corporations (Elections) Rules, 2006 for affixing the photo of the Polling Agents in their appointment letter in Form 11, and

WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to emphasise on the production of photo identity proof as evidence by the Polling Agent at the time of entry into the polling station for the ensuing Ordinary Elections to Urban Local Bodies as a measure to curtail impersonation;

(79)-1 [1] (Tamil Nadu Act 11 of 2019), section 8 of the Avadi City Municipal Corporation Act, 2019 (Tamil Nadu Act 24 of 2019), section 8 of the Cuddalore City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 1 of 2021), section 8 of the Kancheepuram City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 2 of 2021), section 8 of the Sivakasi City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 3 of 2021), section 8 of the Karur City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 4 of 2021), section 8 of the Tambaram City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 5 of 2021), section 8 of the Kumbakonam City Municipal Corporation Ordinance, 2021 (Tamil Nadu Ordinance 7 of 2021) and rule 38 and 139 of the Tamil Nadu Town Panchayats, Municipalities and Corporations (Elections) Rules, 2006, the Tamil Nadu State Election Commission specifies that the Polling Agents (including the relief agents) shall show any one of the twelve documentary evidences in original as prescribed for the electors in S.O.No.100/2019/TNSEC/EG2, dated 11.12.2019 and Circular No.C-10/2022 dated 20.01.2022 as proof of his/her identity to the Presiding Officer and Police Personnel at the time of entry into the Polling Station. The documentary evidence shown by him must have his/her photo identity proof of it. Further, the Commission specifies that every Contesting Candidate or his/her Election Agent shall appoint one Polling Agent for each Polling Station and only one Relief Agent to act as the Polling Agent of such candidate at each Polling Station in the ensuing Ordinary Elections to Urban Local Bodies and any one of them shall be present in the Polling Station at a time.

The above identity proof has been prescribed only for the purpose of verifying the identity of the person appointed as Polling Agent and not for any other purpose of scrutinizing other things.
