Declaration of Multistoreyed Residential and Commercial Building Area for construction of Residential and Commercial Buildings at Upplipalayam Village.

The land comprising Survey Numbers 194-1, 200-1 of Upplipalayam Village, Coimbatore Corporation, Singanallur Draft Detailed Development Plan 10. Having an extent of 4.67 Acres is declared as Multistoreyed Building area for Construction of Multistoreyed residential and commercial use building as per Tamil Nadu Multistoreyed and Public Building Rules, 1973 and instructions thereof. In addition to that, it is also requested to ensure the compliance of the following conditions at the time of clearing the building plans.

5. Ramp ratio should be mentioned in the plan as 1:10.

6. Sufficient parking space should be provided near the entrance for physically challenged persons.

7. Suitable drainage facilities and sewage treatment plant should be provided within the complex.

8. Sufficient lifts must be provided as per Tamil Nadu Lift Act and Rules, 1997 and building should satisfy all the Multi- Storeyed and Public Building Rules, 1973.

9. Fire extinguishers should be provided wherever necessary and also no objection certificate must be obtained from the Fire Service Authority.

10. Rainwater harvesting must be provided as per GO. Ms. No. 138, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 11th October 2002 and arrangements should follow the contour of the site. Detailed map should be produced.

11. Suitable arrangement should be made for tapping solar energy in the buildings as per G.O.Ms.No. 112, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department dated 16th August 2002.

12. FAR and plot coverage should be adopted as per rules and regulations and instructions thereof as applicable to multistoried building.

13. Height between each floor shall not be less than 3m.

14. Open stair-case for emergency escape should be provided in the building.

15. Expansion joints of 75mm gap have to be provided in the building at 45 metres intervals.

16. No Objection Certificate from local body or Highways Department about road widening if any should be provided

17. Necessary lightning arresters should be provided

18. The adequacy of STP has also to be certified by an authority for recycling of waste water.

19. The applicant should furnish the full detailed report about the water supply (both drinking and other purposes) and necessary undertakings to obtain water from the Government desalination plants to provide sufficient water supply to the consumers in the building without excessive extraction of more ground water in that area.

20. Affidavit regarding stability of the building which has to be duly signed by the Architect, owner and structural design engineer in a Rs. 100/- Stamp paper on the following norms.

'Structural designs are made after conducting due soil test of the site as per National Building Code, 2005 so as to be safe against all natural calamities like earthquake, etc., and the structure will be safe in all respects and we all are held responsible for the structural safety/stability.

(1) The Channel on the northern side of the site should not be polluted by any kind of waste material as instructed in G.O.Ms.No. 221, Housing and Urban Development Department (UD4(1) Department, dated 10-07-2007.

(2) The applicant should hand over the site intended for formation of 40feet C2C2 scheme road as gift, to the Corporation before getting planning permission, as instructed the above G.O.

(3) The applicant should make arrangement to shift the HT and LT lines passing through this site at his own expenses.
