CO-OPERATION, FOOD AND CONSUMER PROTECTION DEPARTMENT

Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Rules, 1988.

[G.O. Ms. No. 141, Co-operation, Food and Consumer Protection (CJ1), 17th September 2009.]

No. SRO A-36/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 180 of the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Act, 1983 (Tamil Nadu Act 30 of 1983), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Rules, 1988:—

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 85 for the first proviso to sub-rule (2), the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:—
"Provided that no expenditure under clauses (a),(b) or (c) shall exceed:—

- (i) rupees thirty thousand in the case of a primary society;
- (ii) rupees seventy five thousand in the case of a central society; and
- (iii) rupees one lakh fifty thousand in the case of an apex society".

HOME, PROHIBITION AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT

Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Mass Wine Rules, 1984.

[G.O. Ms. No. 51, Home, Prohibition and Excise (III), 1st September 2009, ஆவணி 16, திருவள்ளுவர் ஆண்டு-2040.]

No. SRO A-37/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 54 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act, 1937 (Tamil Nadu Act X of 1937), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Mass Wine Rules, 1984:—

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 4, in sub-rule (2), for the expression commencing with the words "treasury receipts" and ending with the words "two hundred", the following expression shall be substituted, namely:—

"treasury receipts in proof of the payment of application fee of rupees one hundred, a fee of rupees ten thousand for the grant of privilege of manufacturing Mass Wine and a licence fee of rupees fifty".
