NOTIFICATIONS BY GOVERNMENT

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT

Ad hoc Rules relating to the Tamil Nadu Engineering Subordinate Service for the Temporary Posts of Technical Assistants in the Fisheries Department.

[G.O. Ms. No. 307, Animal Husbandry and Fisheries, 22nd September 1992.]

No. SRO B-86/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:—

2. The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 12th January 1983.

RULES

The General and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu Engineering Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts of Technical Assistants (Civil/Electrical) sanctioned in the Fishing Harbour Project Circle under the control of the Fisheries Department subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.

2. *Constitution.*—The posts shall constitute a distinct class in the said service.

3. *Appointment.*—Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:—

(1) by direct recruitment; or

(2) by recruitment by transfer from any other service.

4. *Appointing Authority.*—The appointing authority for the post shall be the Superintending Engineering, Fishing Harbour Projects Circle, Madras.

5. *Qualification*—(a) *Age*—No Person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment if he has completed or will complete 28 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made:

Provided that the age limit shall be increased by 5 years in respect of candidates belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes:

Provided further that in the case of persons recruited from work charged establishment, the period of their continuous service thereon shall be reduced while computing the maximum age limit.

(b) *Other Qualification:* No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the method of appointment specified in column (1), of the Table below, unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:—

Direct recruitment	Must have passed the Diploma in Civil Engineering, Diploma in Electrical Engineering awarded by the Technological Diploma Examination Board, Madras; or Must possess a Diploma in Civil Engineering or Electrical engineering awarded by the university or Institution recognized by the University Grants Commission for purpose of its grants.
Recruitment by transfer (from Works Inspector, Grade-I)	(i) Must have passed the S.S.L.C. with bifurcated Engineering Course; (ii) Practical experience for a period of not less than 2 years; and (iii) Must have put in 10 years of service in the post of Works Inspector, Grade-I.

<i>Method of appointment.</i>	<i>Qualification.</i>

Recruitment by Transfer (from Others)	Must have passed Diploma in Civil Engineering, Diploma in Electrical Engineering, awarded by the Technological Diploma Examination Board, Madras and must have put in 4 years of regular service in the respective category; or Must possess a Diploma in Civil Engineering or Electrical Engineering awarded by the University or Institution recognised by University Grants Commission for purpose of its grant.

6. *Reservation of Appointments.*— The rule relating to reservation of appointment (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the post by direct recruitment.

7. *Probation.*—Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall from the date on which he joins duty be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. *Test.*— A probationer in the category of Technical Assistant (Civil/Electrical) shall, within the period of his probation, pass the Account Test for Public Works Officers and Subordinates, part I and part II, failing which his second and subsequent increments shall be stopped without cumulative effect till, such time he passes the test. Such stoppage shall not have the effect of postponing his further increments, after he has passed the test, provided that persons who have already passed the test need not pass the test again.

9. *Unit for seniority.*—Seniority shall be maintained on a Statewide basis.

10. *Postings and Transfers.*— Postings and transfers shall be made by the Superintending Engineer, Fishing Harbours Projects Circle, Madras within the Division and from one division to another.

11. *Pay.*—The acting incumbents in the posts shall be paid in the scale of pay of Rs.1350-30-1440-40-1800-50-2200, as applicable to the staff working in the Public Works Department.

PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS DEPARTMENT

Amendments to the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules.

No. SRO B-87/2009—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services Rules (in Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987).

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on 2nd November, 2009.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,—

- (i) in PART I - PRELIMINARY, in rule 2, after clause (5), the following clause shall be added, namely:—
“(5.A)—‘Committee on Appeals’ is a committee as specified in rule 58.”;
- (ii) in PART II - GENERAL RULES, after rule 57, the following rule shall be added, namely:—

“58. *Committee on Appeals*:—(a) The Committee on appeals shall consist of:—

(b) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules or in the Special Rules subject to the period of limitation specified in this regard, an application for revision of seniority under sub-rule (f) of Rule 35, a petition for revision of list of approved candidates under rule 37 or an appeal or review under rule 57 in which the Government are the appointing, appellate, revisionary or reviewing authority, as the case may be, shall be disposed of as hereinafter provided.

(c) An application or petition referred to in sub-rule (b), shall be referred to the Committee on Appeals by the administrative department concerned apprising the full facts of the case for its advice. The Committee on Appeals shall consider the same and tender its advice on the matters so referred to the Committee, for getting orders from Government. The administrative department concerned shall, thereafter without again referring the matter to the advisory departments such as Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Law and Finance referred to in sub-rule (a), subject to the consultation with Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission where such consultation is necessary only as per the Constitution of India and the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations, 1954, pass order on the application or petition, as the case may be, which shall be final.”
