COMMERCIAL TAXES AND REGISTRATION
DEPARTMENT**Exemption in respect of tax payable by any dealer on the sale of the goods to Thiruvallargal Isha Foundation, Coimbatore for certain period under the Tamil Nadu Value Added Tax Act.**

[G.O.Ms. No. 12, Commercial Taxes and Registration (B2), 2nd February 2010, Thai 20, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2041.]

No. II(2)/CTR/95/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 30 of the Tamil Nadu Value Added Tax Act, 2006 (Tamil Nadu Act 32 of 2006), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes an exemption in respect of tax payable under the said Act by any dealer on the sale of the following goods to Thiruvallargal Isha Foundation, Coimbatore, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

(i) The seller shall furnish a declaration duly filled in and signed by the said Foundation in the Form appended below along with the monthly return to the assessing officer;

(ii) The goods purchased shall be for the bonafide use of running Thiruvallargal Isha Foundation, Coimbatore:—

- (I) Medical and surgical equipments;
- (II) Medicines and drugs;
- (III) Laboratory equipments, x-ray films and instruments;
- (IV) Consumables such as gloves, gauze and bandages, intravenous sets, plasters and adhesive plasters;
- (V) Lien pillows, hospital beds and cots and implements for treatment of patients;
- (VI) Vehicles for the project;
- (VII) Blood transfusion sets, blood donor sets;
- (VIII) Computers, Typewriters, duplicators, Xerox machines and other office equipments;
- (IX) Electrical goods, furniture, building materials hardware, refrigerators, water coolers;
- (X) Audio visual aid, public address system;
- (XI) Body Building materials for conversion of Ambulances, Medical Mobile Clinics; and
- (XII) Sanitary and kitchen equipments.

2. The Notification shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January 2010 and shall remain in force upto and inclusive of the 31st December 2014.
