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**BILLS INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE
STATE OF TAMIL NADU**

Under Rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 28th March 2013 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:—

L.A. Bill No. 5 of 2013

A Bill to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013.

BE in enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2013.

Withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013.

2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State sums not exceeding seventy six thousand six hundred and nine crore forty three lakhs and seventy six thousand rupees being moneys required to meet—

(a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2013, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.

A Bill to provide for the appropriation of certain further moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2012.

BE in enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation Act, 2013.

Supplementary appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2012.

2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2012, a further sum not exceeding six thousand one hundred and thirteen crore thirty six lakhs and sixty six thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet—

(a) the supplementary grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for that year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the supplementary expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS
