ACT No. 28 OF 2024.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Act, 1987.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

- (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Produce Marketing (Regulation) Amendment Act, 2024.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 30th day of November 2023.

Amendment of section 33.

2. In section 33 of the Tamil Nadu Agricultural Produce Marketing Tamil Nadu Act 27 (Regulation) Act, 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in the proviso to sub-section (1), for the expression "twelve years and six months", the expression "thirteen years and six months" shall be substituted.

Validation.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act, every person exercising the powers and discharging the functions of a Special Officer of the market committees, with effect on and from the 30th day of November 2023, shall be deemed to have been appointed as such Special Officers under sub-section (1) of section 33 of the principal Act, as amended by this Act, and anything done or any action taken by the said Special Officers during the period commencing on the 30th day of November 2023 and ending with the date of publication of this Act in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, shall be deemed to have been validly done or taken under the principal Act, as amended by this Act.

ACT No. 29 OF 2024.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Short title and Tenders (Second Amendment) Act, 2024.
 - commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Tamil Nadu Act 43 of 1998.

2. In section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998, Amendment of for clause (j), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

section 16.

"(j) of consultancy and financial services from the Tamil Nadu Urban Infrastructure Financial Services Limited with the prior approval of the Government:

Provided that a committee, consisting of the Secretary to Government of the Department concerned, the Secretary to Government, Finance Department and the Managing Director of the Tamil Nadu Urban Infrastructure Financial Services Limited, shall determine the fee for the services to be procured;".

ACT No. 30 of 2024.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commenced on the 1st day of April 2024.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2024.
- 2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year commenced on the 1st day of April 2024, a sum not exceeding Four Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand Two Crore Eighty One Lakh Fifty Four Thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of Three Lakh Nine Thousand Sixteen Crore Seventy Eight Lakh Ten Thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2024, being moneys required to meet--
 - (a) the grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
 - (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.3) Act, 2024.
- 2. The sum specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to one hundred sixty seven crore sixteen lakh thirty seven thousand and ninety three rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2017, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.
- 3. The sum deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State under section 2 shall be appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2017.

ACT No. 33 OF 2024.

An Act to provide for the authorisation of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent on certain services and purposes during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2019 in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No.5) Act, 2024.

Short title.

2. The sum specified in column (5) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to one thousand four hundred eighty crore fifty four lakh seventy one thousand two hundred and seventy five rupees shall be deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule during the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2019, in excess of the amounts authorised or granted for those services and purposes for that year.

The sum deemed to have been authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State under section 2 shall be appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ended on the 31st day of March 2019.
