**Amendments to the General Provident Fund (Tamil Nadu) Rules.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 199, Finance Allowances, 7th June 2024, Vaikasi 25, Kurothi, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2055.]

No. SRO B-23/2024.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the General Provident Fund (Tamil Nadu) Rules:-

2. (a) Amendments (1) and (2) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September 2009.
- (b) Amendment (3) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of January 2023

## AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in rule 9, in sub-rule (9), in clause (1):-

- (1) in sub-clause (b), for the expression "6 per cent", the expression "12 per cent" shall be substituted;
- (2) in sub-clause (c), including the note thereunder for the expression "6 per cent", the expression "12 per cent" shall be substituted;
- (3) after sub-clause (c), the following sub-clause shall be added, namely:-

"(d) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), in the case of Government Servants whose General Provident Fund subscription during a financial year is likely to exceed Rs. 5 lakh even with minimum monthly subscription of 12% of the emoluments, deduction of General Provident fund subscription from the salary shall be stopped as soon as the total contribution in the Financial year reaches Rs. 5 lakh;

Provided that where General Provident Fund subscription during the financial year 2022-2023:-

- (i) has already exceeded the threshold limit of Rs. 5 lakh, no further deduction shall be made in the said financial year;
- (ii) has not reached/exceeded the threshold limit of Rs. 5 lakh, further deduction during the said financial year shall be phased out in such a manner that the total subscription during the said financial year does not exceed Rs. 5 lakh;
- (iii) is likely to exceed Rs. 5 lakh even with minimum monthly subscription of 12% of the emoluments, deduction from the salary shall be stopped as soon as the total contribution in the said financial year reaches Rs. 5 lakh."
