I. VESTING OF PROPERTIES.

Whereas, an application has been made to the Government of Tamil Nadu under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890 (Central Act VI of 1890) by Dr. P. Elumalai, Ph.D., Vinayagapuram, Thirumani Post, Vandavasi Taluk, Thiruvannamalai-604 504, the donor of the said Endowment for vesting the property specified in the the Schedule below, in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments, Chennai, appointed under section 3 of the said Act for the State of Tamil Nadu, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the said Act, hereby orders that the said property be vested in the Treasurer aforesaid, and be held by him and his successors in office, subject to the provisions of the said Act and the Rules which from time to time, may be or shall be made or deemed to have been made thereunder and subject to the conditions set forth in the Scheme settled under section 5 of the said Act, for the administration of the said Endowment.

(i) The meritorious student of Third year under graduate course in Chemistry in English and Tamil medium (other than those belonging to Adi Dravida Community), who secures the highest marks in the University Examination will be given either books or metal trophy; and

(ii) The meritorious student belonging to Adi Dravida Community of Third year under graduate course in Chemistry in English and Tamil medium, who secures the highest marks in the University Examination will be given either books or metal trophy.

3. The unutilized amount of the interest shall be added to the corpus of the Fund.

4. The decision of the administrator will be final.

5. The amount of the said Fund shall be invested from time to time and reinvested in Government Securities.

2. And, Whereas, the Government are satisfied that the said Financial Establishment is not likely to return the deposits to the depositors and hence, the Government have to protect the interests of such depositors;

3. And, Whereas, in the G.O. Ms. No. 1440, Home (Pol. 19), dated 15th October 2007 and G.O. Ms. No. 1846, Home (Pol. 19), dated 17th December 2007, the Government have already made an ad-interim order under Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1997 (Tamil Nadu Act 44 of the 1997) attaching certain immovable properties of some of the partners of the said Financial Establishment as specified in the schedule thereto, and the said properties are not sufficient for repayment of the deposits;

In the letter second read above, the Principal Secretary to Government and Director, Department of Economics and Statistics has sent the proposals for preparation of panel for the year 2008-2009 for the post of Assistant Director of Statistics by Recruitment by Transfer in the Economics and Statistics Department. After careful examination, the proposals were sent to Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department for arriving the estimate of vacancies for preparation of panel for the year 2008-2009. The Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, while approving the estimate of vacancy, indicated that the proposals may not be approved by the Staff Committee before sending panel to the Departmental Promotion Committee in Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. The Staff Committee has approved the estimate of vacancies for the year 2008 -2009 in respect of the post of Assistant Director of Statistics to be filled by Recruitment by Transfer as 7 (Seven) and to be filled in by Direct Recruitment as 2 (Two).

2. In the letter third read above, Government has sent the proposals to the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission and requested to convene the Departmental Promotion

Committee meeting for obtaining approval of panel for the post of Assistant Director of Statistics in the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission for the year 2008 -2009. In the letter fifth read above, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has communicated the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee for the panel to the post of Assistant Director of Statistics in the Tamil Nadu Statistics Service for the year 2008 -2009 for appointment by Recruitment by Transfer.

3. The Government after accepting the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee of Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, approve the panel of 7(Seven) Statistical Officers for the post of Assistant Director of Statistics for the year 2008-2009. Out of the 7 estimate of vacancies for the post of Assistant Director of Statistics only 6 candidates were selected and one post of Assistant Director of Statistics has been kept vacant as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P.No.19219/2008 and M.P.No.1/2008, dated 11-8-2008. The names of the following 6 (Six) Statistical Officers have been included in the panel of Assistant Director of Statistics for appointment by Recruitment by Transfer as Assistant Director of Statistics in Category III of the Tamil Nadu Statistics Service, in the order of preference indicated below:-

**Order of detention of certain person and direct to appear
before certain Official under the Conservation of Foreign
Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act.**

No.II(2)/PUSC/483/2008.—Whereas, an order had been made by the Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O.No.SR.I/489-6/2008. Public (SC) Department, dated 12th August 2008 under Section 3 (1) (i) of the Conservation of Foreign

Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act, 1974 (Central Act 52 of 1974), directing that Tmt. Fathima, wife of Thiru Ibrahim, resident of Old No. 48, Malayappan street, Mannady, Chennai, be detained.

And, Whereas, the said Thirumathi Fathima, wife of Thiru Ibrahim, resident of Old No. 48, Malayappan street, Mannady, Chennai cannot be found.
