HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

Amendment to ad hoc Rules relating to Technical Education Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 447, Higher Education (B1), 10th November 2008.]

No. SRO B-54/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Amendments to the rules published with the Education and Public Health Department Notification No. SRO.A 670 of 1964, dated the 1964 at pages 670-672 of Part V of the *Fort St. George Gazette, dated the 8th July 1964.*

The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th June 1993.

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, in rule 5, in Clause (i) in the entries under the first proviso, the entry,—

“5. Environmental Engineering”

shall be deleted.

HOME DEPARTMENT

Amendments to Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Services.

[G.O. Ms. No. 1357, Home (Pol.VI), 3rd October 2008, Purattasi 17, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2039.]

No. SRO. B-55/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu District Police Act, 1859 (Central Act XIV of 1859) and Sections 9 and 11 of the Chennai City Police Act, 1888 (Tamil Nadu Act III of 1888), read with the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Service (Section 34 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1986).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect from 3rd October 2008.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in Annexure II under the Tabular column in column (2), “(i) against the Category 2, Sub-Inspectors of Police, Category 2A, Sub-Inspectors of Police (finger Print) (Men and Women)” in column (1) thereof, the following proviso shall be added at the end namely:—

“Provided also that for the appointment of a candidate who is a member of Backward Class or Most Backward Class or Denotified communities, the upper age limit shall be 30 years”;

(ii) against Category 5, “Reserve Sub-Inspectors (Men and Women)” in column (1) thereof, the following proviso shall be added at the end namely:—

“Provided also that for appointment of a candidate who is a member of Backward Class or Most Backward Class or Denotified communities, the upper age limit shall be 30 years.”;

(iii) against “Category 7, Constables (Men and Women) (Other than Band Constables, Office of the Director General of Police) and Reserve Constables” in column (1) thereof, the following proviso shall be added, at the end namely:—

“Provided also that for appointment of a candidate who is a member of Backward Class or Most Backward Class or Denotified communities, the upper age limit shall be 26 years.”.

Amendments to the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 1529, Home (Prison II), 12th November 2008, ஐப்பசி 27, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2039.]

No. SRO.B-56/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Jail Subordinate Service (Section 17 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th September 1984.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,—

(1) in Part I, in “Branch II”, for the expression, “Social Workers” the expression “Social Case Work Experts” shall be substituted;

(2) in Part II, in “Branch II” , for the expression “Social Worker” wherever occurs, the expression “Social Case Work Expert” shall be substituted.

PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS DEPARTMENT**Amendment to Fundamental Rules.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 197, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (FR-IV), 24th October 2008, Aippasi 8, Thiruvalluvar Andu-2039.]

No. SRO B-57/2008.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309, read with Article 313, of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st July 2006.

AMENDMENT

In the said Fundamental Rules, in rule 56, in sub-rule (3), in clause (d), for sub-clauses (i) and (ii), the following sub-clauses shall be substituted, namely:—

(i) A Government servant including a Government servant in the Tamil Nadu Basic Service retiring voluntarily shall be given a weightage not exceeding five years, subject to the condition that the total qualifying service rendered by such Government servant including, weightage does not in any case exceed thirty years of qualifying service or it does not take him beyond the date of superannuation, as the case may be. The weightage shall be calculated as specified in the Table below:—

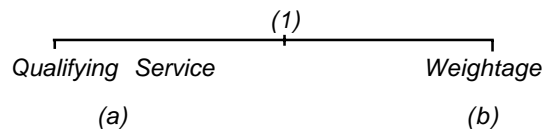

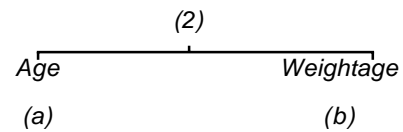
For all the Government servants other than the Government servants in the Tamil Nadu Basic Service:—

53 years and below	5 years of weightage
54 years	4 years of weightage
55 years	3 years of weightage

57 years	1 year of weightage

For the Government servants in the Tamil Nadu Basic Service:—

55 years	5 years of weightage
56 years	4 years of weightage
57 years	3 years of weightage
58 years	2 years of weightage
59 years	1 year of wightage

(ii) The weightage given shall be in addition to the actual qualifying service for purposes of pension and gratuity only, and it shall not entitle a Government servant retiring voluntarily to any notional fixation of pay for purposes of calculating the pension and gratuity. The pension shall be determined based on the 50% of the average emoluments drawn during the last ten months of service rendered reckoned from the date of voluntary retirement or 50% of Pay plus Dearness Pay last drawn by the Government servant, whichever is higher.”
