## NOTIFICATIONS BY GOVERNMENT

### HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE DEPARTMENT

#### Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Service

[G.O. Ms. No. 418, Health and Family Welfare (AA1), 16th December 2008,  
Margazhi 1, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2039.]

No.SRO B-11/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Service (Section 21, Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969).

2. (1) The amendments hereby made other than amendment 2 (2) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 21st July 1970.

(2) The amendment 2 (2) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st October 1984.

#### AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, under Branch-1, Medical,—

1. in Rule 1, under Class XIII, Categories 1 and 2 shall be renumbered as Categories 3 and 4, respectively, and before Category 3 as so renumbered, the following Categories shall be inserted, namely:—

*“Category 1: Non-Medical Assistant Professors in Anatomy, Microbiology, Physiology and Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.*

*Category 2: Non-Medical Assistant Professor in Bio-Chemistry in Government Medical Colleges”;*

2. (1) in Rule 3, in the Tabular column under sub-rule (a), under Class XIII, Categories 1 and 2 shall be renumbered as Categories 3 and 4, respectively, and before Category 3 as so renumbered, the following Categories and the corresponding entries shall respectively be inserted in columns (1) and (2), namely:—

*“Category 1: Non-Medical Assistant Professors in Anatomy, Microbiology, Physiology and Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges.*

By transfer from among the holders of the post of Non-Medical Tutors in their respective speciality.

*Category 2: Non-Medical Assistant Professors Bio-Chemistry in Government Medical Colleges.*

By transfer from among the holders of the post of Non-Medical Tutors in Bio-Chemistry.

(2) against Categories 1 and 2 in column (1), as so inserted, for the expression—

“By transfer”, in column (2), the expression “By promotion” shall be substituted.

3. In the Annexure, under Class XIII, the Categories 1 and 2 shall be renumbered as Categories 3 and 4, respectively, and before Category 3, as so renumbered, the following Categories and the corresponding entries shall, respectively, be inserted in columns (1) and (2), namely:—

Class XIII, Category 1 Non-Medical Assistant Professors of Anatomy, Microbiology, Physiology and Pharmacology in Government Medical Colleges

(i) Must have obtained the degree of M.Sc. (Medical Faculty) in the speciality concerned;

and

(ii) Must have experience in teaching for a period of not less than four years.

Class XIII, Category 2 Non-Medical Assistant Professor of Bio-Chemistry in Government Medical Colleges.

(i) Must have obtained the degree of “M.Sc. (Medical or Science Faculty), in Bio-Chemistry.”

and

(ii) Must have experience in teaching for a period of not less than four years.

**Amendment to Ad hoc Rules relating to Tamil Nadu Medical Service.**

Margazhi 1, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2039.]

No. SRO B-12/2009.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the rules published with the Health and Family Welfare Department Notification No. SRO B-278/80, at pages 315-316 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 18th June 1980.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect on and from 16th December 2008.

## AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 4, for sub-rule (b), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(b) *Other Qualifications*.—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post, unless he possesses the following qualifications, namely:—

(i) Must have obtained M.Sc. degree in Speech and Hearing; (or) M.Sc. degree in Audiology; (or) M.Sc. degree in Speech Language Pathology from the All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysore or from any other University or Institution recognised by the University Grants Commission for the purpose of its grant or by the Rehabilitation Council of India; and

(ii) Must have working experience for a period of not less than two years in any Teaching Medical Institution, affiliated to any University recognized by the University Grants Commission for the purpose of its grant:

Provided that if no suitable person with the above experience is available, persons who are, otherwise qualified, shall be selected and an in-service training for a period of not less than six months, shall be given after appointment as part of probation:

Provided further that other things being equal, preference shall be given to released Emergency Commissioned Officers, released Short Service Commissioned Officers and other Ex-servicemen”.
