3. One member elected by the Headmasters of Higher Secondary Schools from each revenue district within the University area.

The election will be held in accordance with rules and procedures for conduct of election by the University Authorities.

Nominations should be made in the prescribed form which may be obtained from the Returning Officer. Nomination papers shall be enclosed in an envelope superscribed "Nomination to the Senate by Teachers of each Affiliated College", "Nomination to the Senate by the Secretaries of the College Committees of the Private Colleges, as defined in the Tamil Nadu Private Colleges (Regulation) Act, 1976 within the University Area" and "Nomination to the Senate by Headmasters of completed Higher Secondary Schools" as indicated below and sent by Registered Post with Acknowledgement due, so as to be received by the Returning Officer within the date and hour fixed or delivered either in person or by messenger to the Returning Officer within the last date and hour fixed. Nomination papers that are not enclosed in an envelope superscribed and sent by Registered Post or are not delivered in person or by messenger as required above shall be declared invalid. An elector shall be eligible to subscribe either as proposer or as seconder in nomination papers only as many times as there are vacancies but not more.
