Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Revenue Subordinate Service.*[G.O. Ms. No. 274, Revenue [Ser.10(2)], 21st September 2011.]*

No. SRO B-35/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Revenue Subordinate Service (Section 28 in Volume-III of the Tamil Nadu Service Manual, 1970:—

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 7, after the proviso to sub-rule (b), the following proviso shall be added namely:—

“Provided further that nothing contained in this sub-rule shall make a Deputy Tahsildar ineligible to get his name included in the list of approved candidates for appointment as Tahsildar, if he has completed police training for a period of two months but has not exercised the magisterial powers for a period of four months, due to any administrative reasons. However, the Tahsildar so appointed shall not be eligible to get posting as ‘Taluk Tahsildar’ or function as ‘Taluk Executive Magistrate’ unless he has exercised the magisterial powers for a period of four months”.
