Election of One nominee by the Senate and Two by the Syndicate to the Committee for recommending a panel of Three names to the Chancellor for the appointment of the Vice-Chancellor.

It is hereby notified that in accordance with sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 12 of the Tamil University Act, 1982 and under the heading "D. Committee for recommending a panel for Vice-Chancellorship" in Chapter XXV of the Tamil University Statutes, elections will be held for nominating one person by the Senate of the University and two persons by the Syndicate of the University to serve on the Committee of five who are to suggest a panel of three names to the Chancellor for the appointment of the Vice-Chancellor. The election will be held in accordance with the Statutes under Chapter XXV. Each member of the Senate shall have the right to nominate not more than one person who is not a member of any of the authorities of the University to the said Committee. Similarly each member of the Syndicate shall have the right to nominate not more than two persons who are not members of any of the authorities of the University to the said Committee. Every nomination by a member of the Syndicate shall be in writing signed by the proposer and seconded in writing by another member of the Syndicate called the seconder in the prescribed form. Similarly every nomination by a member of the Senate shall be in writing signed by the proposer and seconded in writing by another member of the Senate called the Seconder in the prescribed form. The prescribed form may be obtained from the Registrar on a written requisition signed by any member of the Syndicate and the Senate. No nomination shall be valid unless it contain the signatures of both the proposer and the seconder and the nomination shall also be signed by the person proposed expressing his consent to be nominated.

Every nomination must be presented before the Registrar either by the proposer or the seconder or the person proposed before 3 p.m. on Thursday the 17th February 2011.

The Scrutiny of nomination will take place at 3.30 p.m. on the 17th February 2011 at the office of the Registrar, Tamil University, Thanjavur. The proposer or the seconder or the proposed nominee are entitled to be present at the time of scrutiny.

The following is the programme for election:

1. Publication of the list of valid nominations to the candidates validly nominated : Evening of Thursday the 17th February 2011.
2. Last day and hour by which the candidates may withdraw their candidature by notice in writing : Friday 25th February 2011 3 p.m.
3. Despatch of final list of candidates validly nominated if there is to be an election : Evening of Friday the 25th February 2011
4. Date and hour of poll at the meeting : Wednesday 16th March 2011 12.00 a.m.-1.00 p.m. for Syndicate
Thursday 17th March 2011 12.00 a.m.-1.00 p.m. for Senate.

If the number of persons validly nominated and who have not withdrawn is more than one for the Senate and more than two for Syndicate, an election will be held at a meeting of the Syndicate on 16th March 2011 from 12.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and at a meeting of the Senate on 17th March 2011 from 12.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
