- (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2000 (i.e.) 475 points with base 1982=100 and for every rise of one point over and above 475 points, an increase of 17 paise (Seventeen paise only) per day shall be paid as dearness allowance.
- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the 1st April on the basis of the average of indices for the preceding twelve months, namely, from January to December.
- (iii) The first calculation shall, thus, be effective from the date of publication of the Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Consumer Price Index Number for the previous year.

(3) To arrive at monthly wages, the daily rate of minimum wages (both basic wages and dearness allowance) shall be multiplied by 30.

(4) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made in the case of men and women employees.

(5) The minimum rates of wages for Aluminum and Stainless Steel Vessels making will not apply to piece-rate workers, whose average earnings per day is more than or equal to the minimum rates of wages specified in Schedules II and III.

(6) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the existing wages shall be continued to be paid.

No. II(2)/LE/507/2011.—Whereas the Government are of the opinion that doubt has arisen as to the interpretation of clause 3 of the Memorandum of settlement under sub-section (3) of Section 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947), dated the 13th February 1999 between the Managements of Transport Corporations of Tamil Nadu and the Federations of the Central Trade Unions, in respect of the Variable Dearness Allowance;

And, whereas, in the opinion of the Governor of Tamil Nadu, it is necessary to refer the question of the said doubt, as mentioned in the Annexure to this order to the Industrial Tribunal, Chennai.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 36-A of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby refers the said question of doubt, to the Industrial Tribunal, Chennai to decide the same. The Industrial Tribunal, Chennai is requested to submitted its award to Government within three months from the date of receipt of this order.

THE ANNEXURE

According to clause 3 of the Memorandum of settlement under sub-section (3) of Section 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947), dated the 13th February 1999 between the Managements of Transport Corporations of Tamil Nadu and the Federations of the Central Trade Unions.

The Variable Dearness Allowance will be continued to be calculated on a quarterly basis taking into consideration the rise or fall in the average of the consumer Price Index from quarter to quarter. The Variable Dearness Allowance linked to the Consumer Price Index shall be payable at the rate of rupees two only per each point increase over and above 1924 points commencing from 01-10-98. The following factors will be adopted for working out Variable Dearness Allowance.

The following formula will be adopted for working out variable Dearness Allowance.

Variable Dearness Allowance= points for the quarter minus 1924 x Multiplier applicable to the Basic Pay x Rs.2/- While determining average rate for the quarter fraction shall be rounded off to the current nearest number. The quarterly review shall be as per practice for each quarter namely January-March, April-June, July-September, October-December and the variable Dearness Allowance payable for the increase if any in a quarter shall be allowed as per the current practice during the quarter succeeding the quarter in respect of which review is done.

When the practice of calculating the Variable Dearness Allowance was on quarterly basis after taking into consideration the rise or fall in the average of Consumer Price Index as envisaged in the clause 3 of the settlement under Section 12(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act (in the file No. C-1/48078/98), Whether the recovery of the Variable Dearness Allowance in the 2nd quarter paid in the 1st quarter due to fall of Consumer Price Index is justified?
