### INDUSTRIES DEPARTMENT

#### Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Geology and Mining Subordinate Service.

*[G.O. Ms. No. 177, Industries (E1), 23rd December 2010.]*

No. SRO B-7/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Geology and Mining Subordinate Service.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th January 1987.

#### AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,—

(1) in rule 1, for Class II and Category “Drilling Operator”, the following Class and Categories, shall, be substituted, namely:—

Class II “Category 1. Drilling Operator  
Category 2. Mechanical Foreman”

(2) In rule 2, in sub-rule (a), in the table in Class II,—

(a) for the expression  
“Drilling Operator” in column (1), the expression  
“Category 1-Drilling Operator” shall be substituted.

(b) after the expression “Category I-Drilling Operator” as so substituted in column (1) and the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the following expression and entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:—

“Category 2—Mechanical Foreman 1. By direct recruitment ;  
(or)  
2. By transfer from any other class of category;  
(or)  
3. By recruitment by transfer from any other service.”;

(3) in rule 5, after the expression “4. Drilling Operator” in column (1) and the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the following expression and entries shall be inserted, namely :—

“(4-A) Mechanical Foreman 28 years”,

(4) in the Annexure after serial number 4 in column (1) and the category “Drilling Operator” in column (2) and the corresponding entries in columns (3) and (4) thereof, the following serial number, category and entries shall, respectively, be inserted, namely:—

2. By transfer from any other class or category of Recruitment by transfer from any other service.
- (a) Must have passed X standard;
- (b) Must possess a Certificate from the Industrial Training Institute in Engineering Courses of the Government of Tamil Nadu or any equivalent course recognized by the Government of India of the Technical Diploma Examination Board:
- Provided that other things being equal preference shall be given to a person possessing a Certificate in mechanical or automobile engineering; and
- (c) Must possess practical experience in repairing and testing different types of coring and non-coring drills, drill pumps, motor vehicles and generators for a period of not less than seven years; from Government approved workshops.
- (or)
- (2) (a) Must possess a National Trade Certificate in the trade of Mechanic (Motor Vehicles).
- (b) Must possess adequate knowledge in automobile engineering for a period of not less than seven years; from a Government institution or vocational institution authorized by Government, and
- (c) Must have worked as Mechanic for a period of ten years in Government approved workshop."

No. SRO B-8/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Geology and Mining Subordinate Service.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th February 1989.

In the said Special Rules, in rule 5, for the entry "28 years" in column (2) against the expression "(4-A) Mechanical Foreman" in column (2) thereof, the entry "30 years" shall be substituted.

**Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 28, Municipal Administration and Water Supply (ME.1), 28th January 2011.]

No. SRO B-9/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service (Section 23B of Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th March 2004.

## AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,—

(1) in rule 2, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) By direct recruitment from among the categories of Municipal Employees in Class-I or Class-I ‘A’ of the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service and the candidates to be appointed shall be selected based on seniority and assessment by a Selection Committee consisting of the following officials:—

The Director/Commissioner of Municipal Administration.	Chairman.
The second level officer of the Directorate/Commissionerate of Municipal Administration in-charge of the Municipal Commissioners’ establishment	Member-Secretary.
An officer nominated by the Secretary to Government, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department	Member.

Provided that the appointment shall be made by the Government with the concurrence of the Commission.

Provided also that the guidelines followed in respect of selection through Departmental Promotion Committee be followed by the Selection Committee.”;

(2) in rule 4, in the Table, in column (1), for item (a), the following item shall be substituted, namely:—

“(a) By direct recruitment from the categories of Municipal Employees in Class I or Class IA of the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service.”;

(3) in rule 5, after the expression “15th March of every year”, the following expression shall be added, namely:—

“for the purpose of recruiting Municipal Employees as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II by direct recruitment through a Selection Committee specifically constituted for the purpose, the crucial date on which the Municipal Employees should possess the prescribed qualifications shall be 15th March of every year.” ;

(4) in rule 6, after the words “Open Market” the words “or from among Municipal Employees” shall be inserted;

(5) in rule 7, after the words “Open Market” the words “or from among Municipal Employees” shall be inserted.
