

Right No. 3—To proceed from Pathimadugu Village to Karnataka State,

This pathway starts from pathimadugu village Survey Number 17 southern side at a distance of 42.2 metres, from West to East and proceeded in this Forest Block and reaches the boundary line at 77.4 meter from North to south at eastern boundary of Survey Field Number 5 of the said village. This path way is allowed for the pattadars of Survey Number 5 and 6, to ingress and egress for bringing the cattles to grazing the field and for transportation of inputs and other things and for the people of Pathimadugu village proceeded to Karnataka border, which is adjacent to this Forest Block.
