Acquisition of Lands

[G.O. (2D) No. 15, Highways and Minor Ports (HQ2),
13th July 2012.]

No. II(2)/HWMP/451/2012.—The Governor of Tamil Nadu having been satisfied that the lands specified in the Schedule

below have to be acquired for highways purpose, to wit for formation of Bye-pass Road to Rasipuram Town at Namakkal District and it having already been decided that, the entire amount of compensation to be awarded for the lands is to be paid out of the funds controlled or managed by the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department, Chennai-5 and having considered the cause shown by the owners or other persons having interest on the said lands as the case may be do hereby publish the following Notification, under sub-section (1) of Section 15 of the Tamil Nadu Highways Act, 2001 (Tamil Nadu Act 34 of 2002).

LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT

Exemption to the Tamil Nadu Fisheries Development Corporation Limited, Chennai for certain period under Employees State Insurance Act.

[G.O. (D) No. 307, Labour and Employment (L1), dated 5th July 2012, 22 Aani, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2043.]

No. II(2)/LE/452/2012.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 87 read with Section 91-A of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (Central Act XXXIV of 1948), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the Tamil Nadu Fisheries Development Corporation Limited, Chennai from the operation of the said Act for the period from 19-07-2012 to 18-07-2013 .

(1) The above exemption is subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- The aforesaid Corporation wherein the employees are employed shall maintain a Register showing the names and designations of the exempted employees.
- Notwithstanding the exemption, the employees shall continue to receive such benefits under the said Act to which they might have become entitled to on the basis of the contributions paid prior to the date from which exemption granted by this Notification operates.
- The contribution for the exempted period, if already paid shall not be refunded.

(2) The employer of the said Corporation shall submit in respect of the period during which that Corporation was subject to the operation of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said period") returns in such form and containing such particulars as were due from it in respect of the said period under the Employees State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950.

(3) Any Social Security Officer appointed by the Corporation under sub-section (1) of Section 45 of the said Act, or other official authorised in this behalf shall, for the purpose of,—

- verifying the particulars contained in any return submitted under sub-section (1) of section 44 of the said Act for the said period; or
- ascertaining whether registers and records were maintained as required by the Employees State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950 for the said period; or
- ascertaining whether the employees continues to be entitled to the benefits provided by the employer in cash and in kind, being benefits in consideration of which exemption is being granted under this Notification; or
- ascertaining whether any of the provisions of the said Act had been complied with during the period when such provisions were in force in relation to the said workshops and stores be empowered to,—

(a) require the principal or immediate employer to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or

(b) enter any Corporation, office or other premises occupied by such principal or immediate employer at any reasonable time and require any person found in charge thereof to produce to such Social Security Officer or other official and allow him to examine such documents, books and other documents relating to the employment of persons and payment of wages or to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or

(c) examine the principal or immediate employer, his agent or servant, or any person found in such Corporation office or other premises, or any person when the said Social Security Officer or other official has reasonable cause to believe to have been an employee; or

(d) make copies of or take extracts from any register, account book or other document maintained in such Corporation office or other premises.

Order of Detention of certain person and direct to appear before certain official under Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act.

[G.O. No. SR.I/105-14/2012, Public (SC), 23rd July 2012.]

No. II(2)/PUSC/454/2012.—Whereas, an order had been made by the Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O.No.SR.I/105-9/2012, Public (SC) Department, dated 21-6-2012 under Section 3(1)(i) of the Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act, 1974 (Central Act 52 of 1974), directing that Thiru Syed Mohamed Buhari, S/o. Thiru Kader Mohideen, resident of No. 13/46-A, Hussain Hajjar Nagar, 500 Plot, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District and No.15/176, Ahmed Street, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District, be detained;

AND WHEREAS, the said Thiru Syed Mohamed Buhari, S/o. Thiru Kader Mohideen, resident of No. 13/46-A, Hussain Hajjar Nagar, 500 Plot, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District and No. 15/176, Ahmed Street, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District, cannot be found;

AND WHEREAS, the Government of Tamil Nadu have reasons to believe that the said Thiru Syed Mohamed Buhari, S/o. Thiru Kader Mohideen, resident of No. 13/46-A, Hussain Hajjar Nagar, 500 Plot, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District and No. 15/176, Ahmed Street, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District, in respect of whom the detention order has been made, has absconded and is concealing himself so that the said detention order cannot be executed.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 (1) (b) of the Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act, 1974 (Central Act 52 of 1974), the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby direct the said Thiru Syed Mohamed Buhari, S/o. Thiru Kader Mohideen, resident of No. 13/46-A, Hussain Hajjar Nagar, 500 Plot, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District and No. 15/176, Ahmed Street, Keelakkarai-623 517, Ramanathapuram District, to appear before the Superintendent of Police, Ramanathapuram District, Ramanathapuram at his office within a period of 15 days (fifteen days) from the date of publication of this order in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*.
