Revision of Minimum Rates of Wages for Employment in Handloom Silk Weaving Industry under Minimum Wages Act.

[G.O. (2D) No.20, Labour and Employment (J1),
31st May 2012.]

No.II(2)/LE/466/2012.—The following draft of a Notification, which it is proposed to issue in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 3 and sub-section (2) of Section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948), is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the said Act.

Explanations:—

(1) *Dearness Allowance*:—(i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the year 2000, (namely 475 points with base 1982=100) and for any further rise of every point over and above 475 points an increase of 18 paise per day (eighteen paise only) shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the 1st April on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding 12 months namely, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall, thus, be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year.

(2) Where the same work or work of a similar nature is performed by women, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.

(3) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.

(4) In respect of general items of work, the employees will not be entitled to get dearness allowance for the additional days taken by them in excess of the average production norms fixed under column (3).
