The Notification GSR No. 834 (E) dated the 22nd November 2011 issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Shipping and published in Part II, Section 3, sub-section (i) of the Extraordinary issue of the Gazette of India, dated the 25th November 2011 is republished hereunder as required under Section 132(2) of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963:—

GSR No. 834 (E)—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (i) of Section 124, read with sub-section (i) of Section 132 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 (38 of 1963), the Central Government hereby approves the Chennai Port Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2011 made by the Board of Trustees for the Port of Chennai further to amend the Chennai Port Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Regulations, 2008 and are set out in the Schedule annexed to this Notification.

SCHEDULE**Chennai Port Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2011.**

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 28 of the Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 (38 of 1963), the Board of Trustees of the Port of Chennai hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Chennai Port Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Regulations, 2008, namely:—

1. Short Title and Commencement:—

(a) These Regulations may be called the Chennai Port Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Amendment Regulations, 2011.

(b) The said amendment Regulations shall come into force from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule attached to the Chennai Post Trust Employees' (Recruitment, Seniority and Promotion) Regulations, 2008, the following Recruitment Rule to the post of Deputy Secretary (PR) shall be included next to Sl. No. 3, the Recruitment Rule to the post of Deputy Secretary under General Administration Department:—
