No.II(2)/HOU/263/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 91 of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 (Tamil Nadu Act 35 of 1972), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby authorise the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority in respect of Chennai Metropolitan Area and the Director of Town and Country Planning in respect of the areas other than Chennai Metropolitan Area to exercise the powers vested with the Government by Section 113-C of the said Act to exempt any building or class of buildings developed on or before the 1st day of July 2007, from all or any of the provisions of this Act or any rule or regulation made thereunder, subject to the Tamil Nadu Guidelines for the Exemption of Buildings and Assessment and Collection of amount for Exemption, 2012 and the Tamil Nadu Assessment and Collection of amount for Exemption of Buildings Rules, 2012 made in this behalf, by collecting such amount, not exceeding three times of the Guidelines value of the land.

Explanations:—(1) Dearness Allowance.—In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as follows:-

(1) (i) The dearness allowance shall be linked to the Average consumer Price Index Number for Chennai City for the year 2000 (that is, 475 points with base 1982=100) and for every rise of one point over and above 475 points, an increase of 16 paise (Sixteen paise only) per day shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated on the first April of every year on the basis of the average of indices of the preceding twelve months, that is, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average consumer Price Index of the previous year (i.e. from January to December).

(2) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made in the case of men and women employees.

(3) (i) To arrive at the daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(ii) To arrive at monthly wages, the daily rate of wages shall be multiplied by 30.

(4) Wherever the existing wages, are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, such existing wages shall be continued to be paid.
