## BOUNDARIES

## Bit Number I

*North*—This boundary starting from the trijunction point of Survey Filed Numbers 1026/1, 880 of Number 2. Rameswaram Village and Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban Village, the boundary generally runs towards East along the southern side of Survey Field Numbers 880, 881, Southern and eastern side of Survey Field Number 882, southern sides of Survey Filed Number 884, 886 and 897 and reaches the irjunction points of survey

Field Numbers 887, 897 and 888. Thence the boundary turns generally towards South and runs along the western side of Survey Field Number 888, thence turns towards East and runs along the southern side of Survey Field Number 888 and part of 1025 and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 1025, 1026/353 and 1026/1 of the said Village.

*East*—Thence the boundary turns towards South, East, again South and runs along the West, South, again western of Survey Field Number 1026/353 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Number 1026/353, 1026/352, 1026/10 and 1026/1 of the said Village

*South*—Thence the boundary turns towards West and runs along the northern side of Survey Field Number 1026/10, and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 1026/1 and 1026/10 of the said Village junction with village boundary of Number 1. Pamban Village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban village and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number II**

*North*—This boundary starting from the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/354, 1024, 915 of Number 2. Rameswaram Village and runs generally towards East and runs along the southern sides of Survey Field Numbers 915, 916, 917, 932, 933 934 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/354, 934, 935 and 1026/358 of the said village.

*East*—Thence the boundary turns generally towards South and along West, southern sides Survey Field Number 1026/358 and western side of Survey Field Number 1026/357 and north western sides of survey Field Number 1026/356 and western side of survey Field Number 1026/355 reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/353, 1026/354 and 1026/355 of the said village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Number 1026/353 and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 1026/353, 1026/354 and 1024 of the said village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the Eastern side of Survey Field Number 1024 and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number III-A**

*North*—This boundary starting from the trijunction point Survey Field number 1966, 1026/19 and 1026/20 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and runs generally towards East along the West and Southern side of Survey Field Number 966 and reaches trijunction point of Survey Field Number 966, 967 and 1026/21 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*East*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards South along western side of Survey Field Numbers 967, 968, 969, 993, 994, 995, 997, 998 and 999 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1004, 1005/1, 1022 and 1026/363 of the said village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the north-eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 1022 and 1023 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/5A, 1026/363 and 1023 of the said village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 1026/5A, and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/3, 1026/365 and 1026/363. Thence it runs South along the western side of Survey Field Number 1026/365, West, South and Eastern sides of Survey Field Number 1026/364 and South, East, North again eastern sides of Survey Field Number 1026/365, eastern side of Survey Field Number 1026/18 and 1026/19 and reaches the starting point.

*Enclosure.*—Survey Field Number 1026/5B having an extent of 1.20 0 Hectares kept as enclosure within this Bit III-A.

#### **Bit Number III-B**

This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/3, 1026/5A and 1026/4 of Number 2. Rameswaram village runs generally towards East along the southern side of Survey Field Number 1026/5A then turns South along the western side of Survey Field Number 1026/8 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1013, 1026/9 and 1026/4. Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Number 1026/9 and turns to towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 1026/3 of the said village and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number IV**

*North*—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1015, 1014 and 1009/2 of Number 2. Ramaswaram village and it turns South, East North and runs along the West, wouth and eastern sides of Survey Field Number 1009/2 and runs East along the southern side of Survey Field Number 1016 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1016, 1009/2 and 1009/5 of the said village.

*East*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards South along western side of Survey Field Number 1009/5, western side of Survey Field Numbers 1009/3, 4 and turns towards East along the southern side of Survey Field Number 1009/4 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1009/2, 4 and 1008 and turns South and East and runs along the West and southern side of Survey Field Number 1008 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1008. 1026/366 and 1026/367. Thence it runs South and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/366, 1026/367 and 1026/23 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Numbers 1026/23 and 1026/10 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/10, 1010, 1026/367 and 1009/2 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 1010 and 1014 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number V**

*North*—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/368, 1026/366 and 1007 of Number 2. Rameswaram village. Thence it runs generally towards East along the southern side of Survey Field Numbers 1007 and 1006 and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 1006 and 1005/1 and 1026/368. Thence runs generally towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 1006, 1021 and 1022 runs generally towards East along the South, West and eastern sides of Survey Field Number 1004 and southern side of Survey Field Number 1003 and reaches the junction of Survey Field Numbers 1003, 1002, 1005/1 of the said village.

*East*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards South along western sides of Survey Field Number 1002, North, West and southern side of Survey Field Number 1005/2, thence turns towards South and runs along the western sides of Survey Field Numbers 1029, 1030, 1031, 1032, 1033 1034, 1035 and 1228, and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/368, 1228 and 1230 of Numbers 2. Rameswaram village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Numbers 1230, 1231, 1232, 1233 and 1234 (Part) and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1234, 1026/15 and 1026/368 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North and West along the East and northern sides of Survey Field Number 1026/15, northern side of Survey Field Number 1026/16 part, thence turns towards North along the eastern of Survey Field Number 1026/366 and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number VI**

*North*—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban village and Survey Field Numbers 1026/10, 1026/11 of Number 2. Rameswaram village. The boundary runs generally towards East and north-east and runs along the South, south-west side of Survey Field Number 1026/10 and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/23, 1026/10, 1026/11 and 1026/366 and runs East along the southern side of Survey Field Number 1026/366 and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/11, 1026/16 and 1026/366 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*East*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards South along western sides of Survey Field Number 1026/16 and joins the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1026/16, 1026/11 and 1236 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards West along the North and western sides of Survey Field Number 1236 and northern side of Survey Field Numbers from 1237 to 1247 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1247 and 1026/11 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and Survey Field Number

491 of Number 1. Pamban village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban village and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number VII-A**

*North*—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1050/2, 1050/4, Gulf of Mannar, the boundary runs towards East along the southern side of the coastal area of Gulf of Mannar and joins the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1054/4 and 1054 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*East*—Thence the boundary runs towards South along western side of Survey Field Number 1054 and turns West, South, East and South along the north, west and southern side of Survey Field Number 1053 and turns South along the western side of Survey Field Number 1054 and joins the junction of Survey Field Number 1054, 1080 and 1050/4, of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Number 1080 to 1093 and joins point of Survey Field Numbers 1050/4, 1036, 1093 and 1044/3 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Numbers from 1036 to 1042, 1001, 1000, part of 996 and 1044/4, thence turns towards East and North and runs along the south and eastern side of Survey Field Number 1045, thence turns towards North and runs along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 1050/2 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and reaches the starting point.

*Enclosure*—There is a burial ground having an extent of 0.81.0 Hectare in the middle of the bit bearing Survey Field Number 1050/3 of Number 2. Rameswaram village. The Jadayu Theertham having an extent of 1.72.0 Hectare is situated within the bit in Survey Field Numbers 1044/1, 2, 5, of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

#### **Bit Number VII-B**

This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Number 1050/1, 989 and 990. The boundary runs towards East along the southern side of Survey Field Number 989 and 1049 turns South and runs along the western boundary of Survey Field Number 1050/2, and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Number 1046 and 1050/2 and runs North-west along the eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 1046 and 1047 and runs towards North along the eastern side of Survey Field Number 990 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and reaches the starting point.

#### **Bit Number VIII**

*North*—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban village and Survey Field Numbers 1247 and 1249/1 of Number 2. Rameswaram village. The boundary generally runs towards East along with southern side of Survey Field Numbers 1247, 1246, 1245, 1244, 1243, 1242, 1241, 1240, 1239, 1238 and 1237 and western side of Survey Field Numbers 1236 and 1248, and southern side of Survey Field Number 1248 and eastern side of Survey Field Numbers 1248 and 1236 and southern side of Survey Field Numbers 1235, 1234, 1233, 1232, 1231, 1230, 1094, to 1125, 1127, 1134 to 1137 and joins the point of Survey Field Numbers 1137 and 1138 of Number 2. Rameswaram village and Gulf of Mannar.



*South*—Thence the boundary runs towards West along the southern side of Survey Field Numbers 1120 and 1249/1 and northern side of coastal area of Gulf of Mannar and reaches the junction point of Survey Field Number 1249/1 of Number 2. Rameswarm village and Gulf of Mannar and Survey Field Number 491 of Number 1. Pamban village.

*West*—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along the eastern side of survey Field Number 491 of 1. Pamban village and reaches the starting point.

**Bit Number IX**

*West*—North, East—This boundary starting from the junction point of Survey Field Numbers 1054, 1063 and 1126, the boundary runs generally towards North and turns East and South and reaches the junction of Survey Field Numbers 1063, 1054, 1126 of Number 2. Rameswaram village.

*South*—Thence the boundary runs towards West along the northern side of Survey Field Number 1126 and reaches the starting point at South-west corner of the Survey Field Number 1063 of Number 2. Rameswaram villag.

**Admitted Rights**

**1. Gravel Road branching from Rameswaram to Dhanuskodi Highway leading to Jadayu Theertham.**

A gravel road with a width of 6.0 metres branching from Rameswaram to Dhanuskodi Highway leads jadayu theertham running towards South to North in the middle of the Forest Block and gets out of the forest in the northern boundary of Survey Field Numbers 1231 and 1232 of Number 2. Rameswaram village 'F' line 201.2 and 202.8 metres with the following bearing and distance. The above mentioned road also runs on the unused old railway line in Survey Field Numbers 1034, 1035 and 1032 of Number 2. Rameswaram village. Total length of the road within the Forest Block is 423.40 Metres and the width is 6.0 Metres.

**2. Footpath leading to burial ground through the Forest Block.**

A footpath with a width of two metre leads from Serankottai-Kariyoor habitation situated in Survey Field Number 1050/2 of Number 2. Rameswaram village, enters the forest from the Eastern boundary of Survey Field Number 2. Rameswaram

village at 'F' line 468.4 metres leads to the burial ground. The bearing and distance are as follows. Total length of the path within the Forest Block is 690.6 metres and the width is 2.0 metres.

No.II(2)/EF/451/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that it is proposed to constitute the land within the boundaries specified in the Schedule below, as reserve forest and appoints the Special Tahsildar (Forest Settlement), Kallakurichi, *ex-officio* to be the Forest Settlement Officer, to exercise the powers under clause (c) of the said section in respect of the area specified in the schedule.
