From the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden Letter No. WL4.8702/2004, dated 6th August 2012 and 22nd October 2012.

**Order: No. 439, Environment and Forests (FR.5),  
20th December 2012.**

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden in his letter read above has stated that the financial grants sanctioned to Tamil Nadu Bio diversity Board by the National Bio diversity Authority, Chennai and the State Government, are being deposited and maintained in Tamil Nadu Bio diversity Board's account and operated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden, But, the National Bio diversity Authority, Chennai has stated that any financial grants received from National Bio diversity Authority should not only be operated in the Saving Bank Account in the name of Tamil Nadu Bio diversity Board but it should be operated independently by the Member Secretary of the Board.

2. He has therefore requested the Government, to issue necessary orders to open Saving Bank account in the name of Tamil Nadu Bio Diversity Board operated by the Member Secretary of the Board and to close the existing account operated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden in the name of Thiru R. Sundararaju.

3. The Government, after careful examination accept the request of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and direct to open a Saving Bank account in the name of Tamil Nadu Bio Diversity Board operated by the Member Secretary of the Board.

**Exemption of the certain Beedi Companies from the operation of the Employees' State Insurance Act for certain period.**

[G.O.(D) No. 617, Labour and Employment (L1), 27th December 2012, Margazhi 12, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2043.]

No.II(2)/LE/91/2013.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 87 and 88 read with Section 91-A of the Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (Central Act XXXIV of 1948), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempts the following four Beedi Companies from the operation of the said Act for the period from 01-01-2013 to 31-12-2013:—

1. Seyadu Beedi Company, Tirunelveli.
2. Seyadu Home Industries Private Limited, Tirunelveli.
3. Arasan Beedi Company Private Limited, Tirunelveli.
4. Asal Malabar Beedi Depot Private Limited, Tirunelveli.

(1) The above exemption is subject to the following

conditions, namely:—

(a) The aforesaid managements wherein the employees are employed shall maintain a Register showing the names and designations of the exempted employees.

(b) Not with standing the exemption, the employees shall continue to receive such benefits under the said Act to which they might have become entitled to on the basis of the contributions paid prior to the date from which exemption granted by this Notification operates.

(c) The Contribution for the exempted period, if already paid shall not be refunded.

(2) The employers of the said management shall submit in respect of the period during which that managements were subject to the operation of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said period") returns in such form and containing such particulars as were due from it in respect of the said period under the Employees State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950.

(2) Any Social Security Officer appointed by the Corporation under sub-section (1) of Section 45 of the said Act or other official authorized in this behalf shall, for the purpose of:-

(i) verifying the particulars contained in any return submitted under sub-section (1) of Section 44 of the said Act for the said period; or

(ii) ascertaining whether registers and records were maintained as required by the Employees State Insurance (General) Regulations, 1950 for the said period; or

(iii) ascertaining whether the employees continues to be entitled to the benefits provided by the employer in cash and in kind, being benefits in consideration of which exemption is being granted under this Notification; or

(iv) ascertaining whether any of the provisions of the said Act had been complied with during the period when such provisions were in force in relation to the said management be empowered to—

(a) require the principals or immediate employers to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or

(b) enter any management, office or other premises occupied by such principal or immediate employer at any reasonable time and require any person found in charge thereof to produce to such Social Security Officer or other official and allow him to examine such documents, books and other documents relating to the employment of person and payment of wages or to furnish to him such information as he may consider necessary; or

(c) examine the principals or immediate employers his agent or servant, or any persons found in such management office or other premises, or any person when the said Social Security Officer or other official has reasonable cause to believe to have been an employee; or

(d) make copies of or take extracts from any register,

account book or other document maintained in such management office or other premises.

**Explanations:—** (1) *Dearness allowance:* In addition to the above minimum rates of basic wages, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as follows:-

(i) The dearness allowance shall be linked to the Average Consumer price Index Number for Chennai City for the year 2000 that is 475 points (with base 1982=100) and for every raise of one point over and above 475 points an increase of Rs.8.60 (Rupees Eight and paise sixty only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated from the first April of every year on the basis of the average of the indices of the proceeding twelve months, that is from January to December.

(iii) The revision shall be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Consumer Price Index of the previous year.

(2) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made in case of men and women employees.

(3) Where piece workers are employed in any public motor transport, the remuneration paid to each of them for a normal working day shall not be less than the minimum wages fixed for appropriate category.

(4) To arrive at the daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(5) The 'Wages' as defined in clause (h) of section 2 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) shall be the criteria for the purpose of compliance of this Notification.

(6) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, such existing wages shall be continued to be paid.
