**Vesting of Properties and Scheme for Administration relating to “Professor M. Natarajan Endowment Fund” for final MBBS Students of Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai under the Charitable Endowments Act.**

No.II(2)/HFW/348/2014.—In the matter of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890 (Central Act VI of 1890) and in the matter of Endowment Fund for “Professor M.Natarajan Endowment Fund” for the final year MBBS students of Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai.

## I. VESTING OF PROPERTY

Whereas an application has been made to the Government of Tamil Nadu under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890 (Central Act VI of 1890) by Padma Laureate Dr. Mayil Vahanan Natarajan, the donor of the Endowment Fund specified above for vesting Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments appointed under the said Act for the State of Tamil Nadu. The Governor of Tamil Nadu, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the said Act, hereby directs that the said amount be vested in the Treasurer aforesaid and be held by him and his successors in office, subject to the provisions of the said Act and to any rules, which from time to time, may be or shall deemed to have been made thereunder, upon trust for the purpose and the subject to the conditions set forth in the Schemes settled under Section 5 of the said Act, for the administration of the said Fund.

## II. SCHEME FOR ADMINISTRATION

Whereas an application has been made to the Government of Tamil Nadu under clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890 (Central Act VI of 1890) by Padma Laureate Dr. Mayil Vahanan Natarajan, the donor of the Endowment Fund specified above, for settling the Scheme for the administration of the said Fund. The Governor of Tamil Nadu in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the said Act, hereby settles the Scheme set forth in the schedule below for the administration of the said Fund and appoint from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* as the date on which the Scheme as settled shall come into operation.

## SCHEDULE

1. The endowment fund shall be called as “Professor M. Natarajan Endowment Fund” for the final year M.B.B.S students of Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai.

2. The Dean, Government Stanley Medical College, Chennai shall be the administrator of the Fund and shall deposit the amount furnished by the donor Padma Laureate Dr. Mayil Vahanan Natarajan, with the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments, Government of Tamil Nadu, Chennai who will invest or reinvest the amount and proceeds in Government Securities to the best interest of the Fund.

3. Out of annual interest accrued on the said Fund, a Gold Medal shall be awarded to one student based on the examination.

4. The Medal shall be called as “Professor M. Natarajan Gold Medal in Orthopaedics”

5. Final Year M.B.B.S. Students of Stanley Medical College, Chennai alone will be eligible to participate in the examination.

6. The Head of the Department of Ortho and the panel of examiners decided by him shall conduct the examination.

7. The decision of the panel of examiners in selecting the students for Award based on the examination conducted by them shall be final.

8. If the medal is not awarded to any student, then the unutilized interest amount shall be added to the above said corpus fund.
