**Order: No. 133, Environment and Forests (FR.2)
27th November 2014.)**

In the Government order first read above orders were issued for forming the Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee (TNFUSRC) for recruiting frontline staff like Forester, Forest Guard and Forest Guard with Driving Licence and Forest Watcher for Forest Department and its allied Corporations. In the Government order second read above, orders were issued to approve the "Recruitment Procedures / Modalities" for the above said posts. In the Government letter third read above, necessary *erratum* has been issued to the Government order second read above relating to the examination standard to the above said posts. As per the Government order second read above, the written examinations have to be conducted for the post of Forester in General Knowledge etc., as Paper I and General Science as Paper II and for the posts of Forest Guard, Forest Guard with Driving Licence and Forest Watcher, the written examination has to be conducted in General Knowledge.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter fourth read above has stated that, it is learnt from the Teachers Recruitment Board that a committee has to be formed for framing syllabi for the above subjects before setting up of question papers to conduct examinations. As the written examinations for the above posts have been proposed to be conducted shortly, the Tamil Nadu Forest Uniformed Services Recruitment Committee (TNFUSRC) Members have decided to follow the syllabi for the above posts. as follows:-
