#### **Amendment to the Ad-hoc Rules relating to the Post of Health Educator (Non-Medical) in Tamil Nadu Medical Service.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 02, Health and Family Welfare (AA1), 6th January 2014, Margazhi 20, Vijaya, Thiruvalluvar Aandu 2044.]

No. SRO B-7/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the rules published in the Health and Family Welfare Department Notification SRO No. B125 of 1993 at pages 126 and 127 of Part III-Section 1(B) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 18th August 1993.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 14th August 2012.

#### AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 4, for sub-rule (b), for item (ii), the following item shall be substituted, namely:—

(ii) A diploma in Health Education from the All India Institute of Public Health and Hygiene, Calcutta of the Calcutta University; or a post graduate diploma in Health Promotion and Education from the Gandhigram Institute of Rural Health and Family Welfare Trust affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University; or a diploma in Nutrition and Health Education awarded by the Indira Gandhi National Open University.

#### **Amendment to the Tamil Nadu Special Police Subordinate Service Rules.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 1167, Home (Pol.IX), 23rd December 2013.]

No. SRO B-8/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu District Police Act, 1859 (Central XXIV of 1859) and Sections 9 and 11 of the Chennai City Police Act, 1888 (Tamil Nadu Act III of 1888) read with the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Special Police Subordinate Service Rules, 1978 (Section 44 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Service Manual, 1986).

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 7th March 2012.

#### AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 16 in sub-rule (1), for the expression, “22 weeks”, the expression “seven months of basic institutional training” shall be substituted.

#### **Amendment to the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service in the Department of Backward Classes Welfare.**

No. SRO B-9/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service (Section 22 in Volume-III of the Tamil Nadu services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st August 2012.

## AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,—

(1) in rule 2, under category 12, after the entry, “Assistant in the Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department (Non-Technical) (One out of every two substantive Vacancies)”, the following entry shall be added, namely:—

“Assistant in the Backward Classes Welfare Department (Non-Technical) (One out of every three substantive vacancies)”;

(2) in rule 38, in sub-rule (b), in clause (ii), **after the entry “9. Annexure- IX-H - Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department”**, the following entry shall be added, namely:—

“10. Annexure-IX-I - Backward Classes Welfare Department”;

(3) after Annexure-IX-H,—

the following Annexure shall be inserted, namely:—

**“ANNEXURE-IX-I.**

*[Referred to in rule 38 (b) (ii).]*

***Appointment, training and conditions of service of directly recruited Assistants (Non-Technical) in the Backward Classes Welfare Department—***

1. Appointment to the service may be made in the category of Assistant (Non-technical) in the Backward Classes Welfare Department by direct recruitment for employment in the State.
2. The number of vacancies in the State filled up under rule 1 shall not exceed in **any year one third of the total number of vacancies** arising out of substantive vacancies in the post of Assistant in the State in that year.
3. The Director of Backward Classes Welfare shall be the appointing authority.
4. The rule of reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply to such appointments in the State.
5. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age of 30 years on the first day of the July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
6. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment unless he possesses a degree from any University recognized by the University Grants Commission.
7. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
8. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall within the period of probation,—
  - (a) complete the Foundation Training for a period of two months at Civil Services Training Institute, Bhavanisagar, and
  - (b) Pass the following tests, Namely:-
    - (i) Tamil Nadu Government Office Manual Test; and
    - (ii) Account test for Subordinate Officers, Part-I
9. The inter-se-seniority between the directly recruited Assistants and the Assistants appointed by promotion shall be as per the provisions laid down in rule 35(aa) of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services.
10. Consistent with his seniority, a directly recruited Assistant shall be eligible for promotion to any selection category post, provided he has successfully completed his probation and has also passed the prescribed tests.
11. For every such person so appointed, there shall be reserved a substantive vacancy arising in the permanent cadre of the category of Assistant in the Backward Classes Welfare Department. His appointment to a substantive vacancy shall not, however, confer on him any preferential claim to promotion.
12. The directly recruited Assistant shall be allowed Straightaway to draw the minimum of the time scale of pay applicable to the post of Assistant the Training period shall be allowed to count for increment and for probation.
13. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall execute a bond in proper form with two sureties binding himself—
  - (i) agreeing to serve in the Backward Classes Welfare Department for a period of not less than five years; and
  - (ii) in case, he fails to serve as aforesaid, to refund to the State Government the total amount drawn by him as pay and allowances during the period of training”.

**Amendments to the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service in Labour Department.**

No. SRO B-10/2014—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service (Section 22 in Volume-III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970):—

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th October 2012.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,—

(1) in rule 2, under category 12, after the entry, “Assistant in the Backward Classes Welfare Department (Non-Technical) (One out of every two substantive vacancies)”, the following entry shall be added, namely:-

“Assistant in the Labour Department (Non-Technical) (One out of every two substantive Vacancies)”;

(2) In rule 38, in sub-rule (b), in clause (i), after the entry “10. Annexure- IX-I – Backward Classes Welfare Department”, the following entry shall be added, namely:-

“11. Annexure-IX-J – Labour Department”;

(3) after Annexure-IX-I, the following Annexure shall be inserted, namely:—

**“ANNEXURE-IX-J.**

**Appointment, training and conditions of service of directly recruited Assistants (Non-Technical) in the Labour Department:—**

1. Appointment to the service may be made in the category of Assistant (Non-technical) in the Labour Department by direct recruitment for employment in the State.

2. The number of vacancies in the State filled up under rule 1 shall not exceed in any year 50% of the total number of vacancies arising out of the substantive vacancies in the post of Assistant in the State in that year.

3. The Joint Commissioner of Labour (Administration) shall be the appointing authority.

4. The rule of reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply to such appointments.

5. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age of 30 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

6. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment unless he possesses a degree from any University recognised by the University Grants Commission.

7. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

8. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall, within the period of probation:—

(a) Complete the Foundational Training for a period of two months at Civil Services Training Institute, Bhavanisagar, and

(b) Pass the following tests, namely:—

(i). Account Test for Subordinate Officers, Part-I.

(ii). Tamil Nadu Government Office Manual Test.

(iii) Labour and Factories Department Test, Part-A and Part-B.

9. The inter-se-seniority between the directly recruited Assistants and the Assistant appointed by promotion shall be as per the provisions laid down in rule 35(aa) of the General Rules for the Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services.

10. Consistent with his seniority, a directly recruited Assistant shall be eligible for promotion to any selection category post, provided he has successfully completed his probation and also passed the prescribed tests.

11. For every such person so appointed, there shall be reserved a substantive vacancy arising in the permanent cadre of the category of Assistant in the Labour Department. His appointment to a substantive vacancy shall not, however, confer on him any preferential claim to promotion.

12. The directly recruited Assistant shall be allowed straightaway to draw the minimum of the time scale of pay applicable to the post of Assistant. The training period shall be allowed to count for increment and for probation.

13. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall execute a bond in proper Form with two sureties binding himself:—

(i). agreeing to serve in the Labour Department for a period of not less than five years; and

(ii). In case, he fails to serve as aforesaid, to refund to the State Government the total amount drawn by him as pay and allowances during the period of training.”.
