Exemption from the Provisions of Regulation of Second Master Plan for Chennai Metropolitan Area relating to multi storied building for Odisha Bhavan at Pallikaranai Village, Chennai under Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act.

No. II(2)/HOU/208/2015.—In exercise of powers conferred under Section 113 of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act, 1971 (Tamil Nadu Act 35 of 1972) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby exempt the construction of Stilt Floor + 6 Floors building for Odisha Bhavan (Parking in stilt floor, conference room, dining and kitchen in 1st floor, 20 guest rooms in 2nd & 3rd floor, dormitories and 6 guest rooms in 4th floor, auditorium in 5th & 6th floor and meter room in terrace floor) at S.No.26/3 of Pallikaranai Village, 60 feet Road of Tambaram - Velachery Road, Pallikaranai, Chennai from the provisions of violation of Development Regulation 28(2)(A) relating to site extent; Development Regulation 28(2)(B) relating to plot frontage; Development Regulation 28(2)(G) relating to set back violation on the eastern side; Development Regulation 28(2)(6) relating to Corridor width; of Second Master Plan for Chennai Metropolitan Area 2026, allowing architectural features at the top floor level coming within the set back space at all four corners subject to condition that the applicant has to relocate the transformer and generator room proposed in the southern side to stilt area and make the portico on the north as unsupported, rectifying all the other defects and furnishing of No Objection Certificates from Director of Fire and Rescue Service, Traffic Police, Public Works Department and other usual No Objection Certificates must be obtained.
