Amendments to Adhoc Rules relating to the Post of Heart Lung Hypothermia Machine Technician in Tamil Nadu Medical Subordinate Service.

No. SRO B-68/2015.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Rules published with the Health and Family Welfare Department Notification No. SRO B-446/79, published at Pages 549-550 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 10th October 1979.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules.—

1. in rule 1, for the expression “Government General Hospital, Madras”, the expression “Government Medical College and Hospitals” shall be substituted;

2. in rule 4, for the expression “the Dean, Government General Hospital, Madras”, the expression “Dean/Head of the Institution concerned” shall be substituted;

3. in rule 5,—

(i) in sub-rule (a), for the expression “26 Years”, the expression “30 years” shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-rule (b), under “THE TABLE”, for the entries “(ii) By direct recruitment and recruitment by transfer”, in column (1) and the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:—

(ii) By recruitment by transfer from any other service and by direct recruitment.

(i) Must have passed Higher Secondary Course with the following Science Subjects,

(a) Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology or

(b) Physics, Chemistry, Biology with any one of the related subjects; and

(ii) Must have passed one year Certificate Course in Pump Technician Conducted at Government Medical Institutions or in any other Institution recognized by the State or Central Government.

4. in rule 7, after the proviso, the following provisos shall be added, namely:—

“Provided further that on and from the 1st June 1988, the monthly pay shall be calculated in the scale of pay of Rs. 1200-30-1560-40-2040:

Provided also that on and from the 1st January 1996, the monthly pay shall be calculated in the scale of pay of Rs. 4000-100-6000:

Provided also that on and from 1st January 2006, the monthly pay shall be calculated in the Pay Band of Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade Pay of Rs. 2400.”
