Amendment to the Rules to regulate the Public Interest Litigations Framed by the High Court

By virtue of Article 225 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the High Court makes the following amendment to Rule 4 of the Rules to regulate the Public Interest Litigations filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India as published in *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, Part III—Section 2, Issue No. 31, dated 11-08-2010.

AMENDMENT:- For Rule 4, the following Rule shall be substituted namely-

"4. The petitioner must disclose his avocation, annual income and other particulars as to whether he is an Income Tax Assessee or not? If he is an Assessee, he must furnish the PAN number. The petitioner must also disclose whether he has filed the petition out of his own funds or from other sources. If it is the latter, the particulars should be given.
