AMENDMENT

In the said Rules:-

For the following existing Rule 5 - Form for giving information of Births and Deaths:

(i) The information required to be given to the Registrar under section 8 or section 9, as the case may be, shall be in Form Nos. 1,2 and 3 for the Registration of a birth, death and still birth respectively, herein after to be collectively called the reporting forms. Information, if given orally, shall be entered by the Registrar in the appropriate reporting form and the signature (or) thumb impression of the informant obtained.

The following shall be substituted:

The information required to be given to the Registrar under Section 8 or Section 9 as the case may be, shall be in Form-1, Form 1A, Form 2 and Form 3 for Registration of birth, adoption of child, death and Still birth respectively herein after to be collectively called the reporting forms. Information if given orally shall be entered by the Registrar in the appropriate reporting forms and the signature / thumb impression of the informant to obtained.
