**Declaration of Pethathampatty Forest block in Pappireddipatty Taluk in Dharmapuri District as Reserved Forest under the Tamil Nadu Forest Act.**

[G.O. (Ms.) No. 136, Environment and Forests (FR.14), 14th December 2015, கார்த்திகை 28, மன்மத, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2046.]

No. II(2)/EF/295/2016—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the limits of which are specified in the Schedule below, as reserved forest with effect on and from the 26.10.2016.

## THE SCHEDULE

1. Name of the district : Dharmapuri
2. Name of the Taluk : Pappireddipatty
3. Number and Name of the Village : Number 91 (Old No.142) Pethathampatty
4. Survey Number of the forest block : 62
5. Name of the forest block : Pethathampatty Forest Block
6. Area of the Forest Block : 58.93.0 hectares

## BOUNDARIES

**North.**—Starting from the trijunction of Survey field numbers 61, 62 and 56 of Village No.91, Pethathampatty Village, the boundary of the Forest Block generally runs towards east along the southern side of Survey Field Number 61 and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 62, 61 of Number 91, Pethathampatty Village and Village boundary of Village number 97, Achalvadi Village.

**East.**—Thence the boundary generally runs towards South along the common Village boundary of Village number 97, Achalvadi Village and Village Number 91, Pethathampatty Village and reaches the trijunction point of Survey Field Numbers 63, 62 of Number 91, Pethathampatty Village and Village boundary of No.97 Achalvadi Village.

**South.**—Thence the boundary generally runs towards south-west along the northern side of Survey Field Number 63 and reaches the quarter junction of Survey Field Numbers 70, 46, 63 and 62 of Village Number 91, Pethathampatty.

**West.**—Thence the boundary generally runs towards north along the eastern sides of Survey Field Numbers 46, 47, 48, 54, 55 and 56 of Village No.91, Pethathampatty and reaches the starting point.

## Pathway-I:

This pathway starts from Pethathampatty Village Survey Field Numbers 63, 70 and 46 from the corner of Survey Field Number 70 through Survey Field Number 62. This pathway starts from point A, with 12 metres breadth through station 1, 2, 3, 4 with a distance of 121.4 metres, and reached the magnetic bearing station Number 5. Further it starts in magnetic bearing station Number 4, with 12 metres breadth, through stations 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 with a distance of 401.4 metres and reached the Survey Field Numbers.47, 48 and 62 in triangle junction and finished in magnetic bearing station Number 12. The above pathways starts from south side and runs towards north in Survey Field Number 62. Further this pathways starts from point B, with 12 metres breadth, with a distance of 37 metres, and reached the magnetic bearing station No.2. This pathway is allowed to a length of 559.8 metres and 12 metres breadth within the Forest Block.

This pathway starts from Survey Field Number.63, from Western side and runs through Survey Field Number 62 on eastern side and ending in Survey Field Number.63. This pathway runs with 81 metres length and 3 metres breadth.

A submerge pumpset is in (borewell) existence on north-west side. Through this Borewell, the Pillaikottai Village, Achalvadi public is using this for drinking purposes. This pathway is allowed to a length of 115.0 metres and 3.00 metres breadth within the Forest Block.
