Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Handlooms and Textiles Subordinate Service.

No. SRO B-13/2016.—In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Handlooms and Textiles Subordinate Service (Section 43 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 11th January 2016.

#### **A**MENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 11, in sub-rule (a), in "THE TABLE", for the entry in column (2), against the entry "1. Handloom Inspectors; and Senior Technical Assistants appointed by direct recruitment" in column (1) thereof, the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"A course of Training in General Basic Training through correspondence mode, at any of the Institutes of Co-operative Management approved for the purpose from time to time by the Director of Handlooms and Textiles with pass in all the tests conducted at the end of training, within the period of probation. If they do not pass the said tests within the said period, their second and subsequent increments shall be stopped till they pass the said tests, but such stoppage shall not have the effect of postponing their future increments, after they have passed the said tests".
