Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Services.

[G.O. Ms. No. 168, Home (Police VI), 2nd March 2017, மார்ச் 18, துன்புழக்கி, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2048.]

No. SRO B-16/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu District Police Act, 1859 (Central Act XXIV of 1859) and Sections 9 and 11 of the Chennai City Police Act, 1888 (Tamil Nadu Act III of 1888) read with the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Service (Section 34 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual):-

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in Annexure -II, in the tabular column, under Class 1;-

(1) for the entries "Category 2 Sub-Inspectors of Police" and "Category-2A-Sub Inspector of Police (Finger Print) (Men and Women)" in column (1) and the corresponding entries in columns (2) and (3) thereof, the following entries shall, respectively, be substituted, namely:-

<p>"Category 2 Sub- Inspectors of Police</p>	<p>Must have completed the age of 20 years and must not have completed the age of 28 years:</p> <p>Provided that for appointment of a candidate who is a member of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, the Upper Age Limit shall be 33 years:</p> <p>Provided further that for appointment of a candidate who is a member of backward classes or Most Backward Classes or Denotified Communities, the Upper age limit shall be 30 years:</p> <p>Provided also that for appointment of a candidate who is a Destitute Widow, the upper age limit shall be 35 years</p> <p>Provided also that for appointment of a candidate who is an Ex-Serviceman or an Ex-Personnel of the Central Paramilitary Forces, the upper age limit shall be 45 years, subject to the condition that, his candidature shall be considered only for a period of three years after the date of discharge from his Unit:</p> <p>Provided also that for appointment of a candidate by direct recruitment under the departmental quota, the candidate should not have completed 45 years of age as on the 1st July preceding the date of notification of selection.</p>	<p>(1) (i) Must possess a Degree from any University or Institution recognized by the University Grants Commission.</p> <p>(ii) Must have the ability to read and write any one of the following languages, namely, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada or Hindustani.</p> <p>(2) The Departmental Quota Candidates must possess:-</p> <p>(i) A degree from any University or Institution recognised by the University Grants Commission:</p> <p>(ii) five years of service In their respective Categories as on 1st July preceding the date of notification of selection; and</p> <p>(iii) a clean record of Service without any punishment other than the minor punishments of Black Mark, Reprimand and / or Censure.</p> <p>(3) All candidates shall appear for the Written Test first. From out of the candidates qualified In the Written Test, only five times of the number of notified vacancies In each of the categories such as Open Competition, Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Schedule Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted for the next stage of selection, based on the marks obtained In the Written Test.</p>
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- (4) (i) In respect of male candidates, the height shall not be less than 170 centimetres:
 Provided that in the case of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes candidates, the height shall not be less than 167 centimetres.
- (ii) In respect of female candidates, the height shall not be less than 159 centimeters:
 Provided that in the case of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes candidates, the height shall not be less than 157 centimetres.
- (iii) In respect of male candidates, the chest measurement round the chest shall not be less than 81 centimetres on normal condition (on expiration) and shall not be less than 86 centimetres on full inspiration, with a minimum chest expansion of 5 centimetres:
 Provided that the Ex- Servicemen and Ex- Personnel of Central Paramilitary Forces and the departmental quota candidates are exempted from height and chest measurements:
 Provided further that there shall be no chest measurement for female candidates.
- (5) (i) Every male candidate shall undergo a Physical Endurance Test, that is, running 1500 meters in 7 minutes.
- (ii) Every Ex-Servicemen and Ex-Personnel of Central Paramilitary Forces shall undergo a Physical Endurance Test, that is, running 1500 metres in 8 minutes.
- (iii) Every Women candidate shall undergo a Physical Endurance Test, that is, running 400 meters in 150 seconds. i.e. two and half minute.
- (6) The candidates who qualify in the Physical Endurance Test shall undergo the Physical Efficiency Test as specified below:
 Provided that departmental quota candidates are exempted from the Physical Efficiency Test.

Out of the above five events, every candidate shall participate in three events, namely, one jump event, one running event and rope climbing event and shall qualify in all the three events with minimum of one star standard in each of the events.

Out of the above five events, every candidate shall participate in three events, namely, the long jump event, one running event and either shot put or cricket ball throw event and shall qualify in all the three events with minimum of one star standard in each of the events.

Out of the above five events, every candidate shall participate in three events, namely, one jump event, one running event and the shot put event and shall qualify in all the three events with minimum of one star standard in each of the events.

(7) The number of candidates to be called for Viva-voce in each category shall be as follows:-

(i) Open Quota:- From out of the candidates qualified in the Physical Efficiency Test, only two times of the number of notified vacancies in each of the categories such as Open Competition, Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Schedule Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted to viva-voce, based on the marks obtained in the Written Test and the Physical Efficiency Test.

(ii) Departmental Quota:- From out of the candidates qualified in the Physical Endurance Test, only two times of the number of notified vacancies in each of the categories such as Open Competition, Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Schedule Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted to viva-voce, based on the marks obtained in the Written Test.

(ii) The Minimum qualifying marks in the Written Test for the open quota candidates shall be 25 marks out of 70 marks and for the departmental quota candidates it shall be 30 marks out of 85 marks.

(iii) The special marks for both open quota candidates and the departmental quota candidates shall be allotted at the stage of Viva-Voce, after production of the relevant original Certificates or records.

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Provided that the provisionally selected Sub-Inspectors (Armed Reserve) in Category.5 of Class I or Sub-Inspectors in Category. 2 of the Tamil Nadu Special Police Subordinate Service Rules, 1978 recruited under 1994-95 batch and appointed in the year 1997, for appointment as Sub- Inspectors of Police of Taluk by transfer or by recruitment by transfer, as the case may be, need not undergo the training In Police Training College, but must have undergone practical training for Six months and examination conducted by the Police Training College on a centralized basis and further that their performance in the examination will be taken into consideration for assessing their suitability for the appointment and the Sub-Inspectors of Police, who have not made their grade will be repatriated to the Armed Reserve or Tamil Nadu Special Police Battalion, as the case may be.

Explanation.-

- (i) Service rendered as Sub-Inspector of Police In Special Units like Special Security Group, Special Branch CID, Security etc. shall be reckoned for the purpose of Calculation of five years of *service*.
- (ii) All the qualifications shall be reckoned as on the 1st July of the year of selection.
- (iii) The Sub-Inspector of Police shall be given two chances for passing the examination to be conducted at the end of the training, failing which, he shall be repatriated to the original Category that is, Sub-Inspector of Police in the Armed Reserve or In the Tamil Nadu Special Police, as the case may be.

Provided also that for appointment of a candidate by direct recruitment under the departmental quota, the candidate should not have completed 45 years of age as on the 1st July, preceding the date of notification of selection.

- (1) must possess a Degree in Science from any University or Institution recognized by the University Grants Commission.
- (ii) Must have the ability to read and write any one of the following languages, namely, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada or Hindustani.
- (2) The Departmental quota candidates must possess,-
 - (i) a Degree in Science from any University or Institution recognized by the University Grants Commission;
 - (ii) five years of service in their respective categories as on the 1st July preceding the date of notification; and
 - (iii) a clean record of service without any punishments other than the minor Punishment of Black Mark, Reprimand and or Censure.
- (3) (i) All candidates should appear for the Written Test first.
- (ii) In respect of open quota candidates, out of those who are qualified in the written test, only three times of the number of notified vacancies in each of the categories such as Open Competition Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted for next stage of selection, based on the marks obtained in the written test and all the candidates qualified in the Physical Measurement test shall be permitted for viva-voce.
- (iii) In respect of departmental quota candidates, all the candidates qualified in the written test shall be permitted for the next stage of selection (i.e) viva-voce.
- (4) (i) In respect of male candidates, the height shall not be less than 163 centimetres:
Provided that in the case of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes candidates, the height shall not be less than 160 centimeters:
- (ii) in respect of female candidates, the height shall not be less than 154 centimetres:
Provided that in the case of Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes candidates, the height shall not be less than 152 centimetres:
- (iii) Ex-Serviceman and Ex-Personnel of the Central Paramilitary Forces and the departmental quota candidates are exempted from height measurement.

(2) in column (3), against the entry "Category 5 Sub-Inspectors (Armed Reserve) (Men and Women)" in column (1),-

(a) in item (1), for sub-item (iv) the following sub-item shall be substituted, namely:-

"(iv) All the candidates should appear for the Written Test first. From out of the candidates qualified in the Written Test, only five times of the number of notified vacancies in each of the categories such as Open Competition, Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Schedule Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted for the next stage of selection, based on the marks obtained in the Written Test".

"(iii) All the candidates should appear for the Written Test first. From out of the candidates qualified in the Written Test, only five times of the number of notified vacancies in each of the categories such as Open Competition, Backward Classes, Backward Classes (Muslims), Most Backward Classes, Schedule Castes including Arunthathiyar, Schedule Tribes and Women shall be permitted for the next stage of selection, based on the marks obtained in the Written Test."
