No. II(2)/BCMBCMW/318/2017.—The Government have carefully considered the appeal petition dated 27.02.2015 preferred by Thiru R. Ameer Basha under sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Wakf Act, 1995 (Central Act 43 of 1995) to set aside the orders of the Tamil Nadu Wakf Board in its item No.126/14 in Rc.No.12532/ஆ4/12/Kanchi, dated 26.08.2014, and the stay petition dated 27.02.2015. Stay was not granted. It is found that the Tamil Nadu Wakf Board had issued order bringing the Sunnath Jamath Jumma Mosque @ Sheik Khairullah Mosque, Theradi, Kancheepuram District under its direct management as Thiru. R. Ameer Basha has been functioning as Muthavalli without the recognition of the Tamil Nadu Wakf Board. After careful consideration of the issues in the appeal petition, Government have come to the conclusion that there is no illegality or incorrectness in the orders passed by the Tamil Nadu Wakf Board in item No.126/14 in Rc.No.12532/B4/12/Kanchi, dated 26.08.2014. Accordingly, the appeal petition and the stay petition filed by Thiru R. Ameer Basha is hereby rejected.
