## HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

**Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Technical Educational Subordinate Service.**

No. SRO B-63/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Higher Education Department Notification No.SRO B-54(a-3)/2014, published at Pages 2 to 3 in Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* Extraordinary, dated the 15th October 2014.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th October, 2014.

## AMENDMENT

In the said Notification, in the preamble, for paragraph (2), the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely:-

“2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st of April, 2013.”

**Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Industries Service.**

திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2048.]

No. SRO B-64/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Industries Service (Section 19 of Part III-A of the Special Rules for the State Services in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016).

2. The amendments hereby made shall come in to force on the 20th September 2017.

## AMENDMENTS

In rule 4 (b) of the said Special Rules, in the Annexure, for the entries in column (3), against the category “Senior Chemist” in column (1) and the method of appointment “Direct recruitment” in column (2) thereof, the following entries shall be substituted, namely:-

“1. A Post Graduate degree in Chemistry or Industrial Chemistry or an Associateship Diploma of the Institute of Chemists (India), and.

2 Practical experience in the Analysis of Industrial Products for a period of not less than 3 years:

Provided that other things are being equal, preference shall be given to the candidate who possess, in addition, all or any of the following qualifications:-

(i) Publication of Scientific Papers;

(ii) Teaching experience in chemistry at H.Sc or its equivalent standard or higher standard for a period of two years from the Institution recognized by the Government. The above experience should be obtained after acquiring the prescribed educational qualifications and from an authority competent to issue such certificate”.

## PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS DEPARTMENT

**Amendments to the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 125, *Personnel and Administrative Reforms (M)*, 19th September 2017, புரட்டாசி 3, வேறுவிளம்பி, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2048.]

No. SRO B-65/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 318 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission Regulations, 1954 (Volume-I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987).

## AMENDMENTS

In the said Regulations, in ANNEXURE V, in Clause (2),-

(1) for sub-clause (a)(i) the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) (i) Every person appointed to the post of Assistant, Typist and Personal Clerk shall pass the test in the Tamil Nadu Government Office Manual and shall complete the Foundational Training at Civil Services Training Institute, Bhavanisagar and pass the test conducted at the end of training within the period of probation or within a period of two years from the date of appointment where no probation is prescribed and also from promotion as Assistant Section Officer.

Every person appointed to the post of Assistant Section Officer-cum-Programmer by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.”;

(2) for sub-clause (a)(ii), the following sub-clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) (ii) Every person appointed to the post of Assistant Section Officer by direct recruitment shall pass the Departmental Test in the Tamil Nadu Services Manual Volume-I and the Tamil Nadu Government Office Manual and shall also complete the Foundational Training at Civil Services Training Institute, Bhavanisagar and pass the test conducted at the end of training within the period of probation and also for promotion as Section Officer”.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 25th day of November 2016.

No. SRO B-67/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the adhoc rules issued with Transport Department Notification No. SRO B-289/79, Published at Pages 342 to 344 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 6th June 1979:—

2. The amendment (2) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from the 17th May 2012.

## AMENDMENTS

In the said adhoc rules,—

(1) for the expression, “Motor Vehicles Maintenance Organisation” wherever it occurs, the expression “Motor Vehicles Maintenance Department” shall be substituted;

(2) for the expression “Works Manager” wherever it occurs, the expression “General Manager” shall be substituted;

(3) in rules 3, clause (2) shall be omitted;

(4) in rule 4 in the Table,-

(i) in column (2), against the entry (1) “By Promotion” in column (1), clause (1) shall be omitted; and

(ii) The entry “(2) Recruitment by Transfer” in column (1) and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (2) shall be omitted.
